Phoenix Greenways

Platinum Pleasure Ride – 20 May 2018

Routes

- Start at Pleasley Pit Country Park NG19 7PH
- The park is off the roundabout where the A617 meets the A6191 between Chesterfield and Mansfield.
- Take the Chesterfield Road exit signed to Pleasley Village then turn right onto Pit Lane.
- Entry to car park is on Pit Lane (Ordnance Survey grid ref SK 499 643).
- There will be no access to parking before 8.30am.
- Please note that apart from the canter track on the 15 mile route, the Pleasley Pit Country Park Phoenix Greenway Trail is strictly walk and trot only.
- The 3 and 8 mile routes are strictly walk and trot only on surfaced multi user trails and some grassy edges.
- On the 15 mile route there is a purpose built canter path at Tibshelf.
- Please respect other users of the trail and do not trot or canter in their vicinity.

Terms and Conditions

General

- The BHS strongly recommends wearing Hi-Viz when riding and carriage driving.
- Please report to the organisers on arrival and follow the instructions of marshals and officials at all times.
- Please provide vehicle make, model and registration on arrival.
- All riders are responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.
- All riders must have previous experience of riding the horse they have entered into the event.
- Always ride, and carriage drive, with courtesy, care and consideration to fellow users of the route including equestrians, cyclists, walkers, particularly those who may be elderly, disabled, children or simply frightened of horses. Ride slowly past others.
- Do not stray from the planned route or designated areas. Remember horses hooves can damage surfaces in wet weather.
- Leave gates as you find them and ride slowly past all stock.
- If the event incorporates using a road, ensure the Highway Code is adhered to.
- If you return without finishing the ride, for whatever reason, please inform the organisers and return your ride number.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a short lead at all times and be clearly marked with an identification tag displaying a contact number.

You

- Riders under 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of the event.
- Hats to one of the following standards must be worn: PAS015 1998 or 2001, VG1 01.040 2014-12, provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked. ASTM F1163 2004a provided it is SEI marked. SNELL E2001 or E2016. AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked and correctly secured at all times when mounted. - Body protectors are strongly recommended and compulsory when competing and they should be BETA Level 3 (2000 or 2009 purple label). More information can be found on the BHS website at <http://www.bhs.org.uk/safety-and-accidents/common-incidents/what-to-wear/body-protectors>
- All riders must wear suitable riding footwear. Wellington boots and trainers are not allowed.

Your Horse

- All horses must be over the age of four years and of appropriate fitness level for the activity being undertaken – hooves and shoes must be in good condition.
- Tack must be in safe condition and fit correctly.
- Don't forget it is a legal requirement to have your horses' passport when travelling to events.
