7/05/2018 Fun Ride at Nutwith Common, Masham

Park on Nutwith Common, near Roomer Lane on the Masham to Grewelthorpe Road, Masham, North Yorkshire. HG4 4JP.

Come and join us for a ride across the picturesque Swinton Park Estate. Easy and safe hacking over miles of lanes and tracks not usually open to the public. The route has some water crossings along clearly marked routes of either **6 or 12 miles** (approx.). First horse starts at 10am and last at 12pm
All entries taken on the day

£15 for adults

£10 for children under 14

There will be a £2 mandatory bib fee which will be donated to the Air Ambulance.

Rules

- All riders must wear a hat to current BS standards.
- The route will be clearly marked. We have checked the route and have helpers placed at strategic points to assist with gates and road crossings to help make the day as easy and enjoyable as possible. However, all riders take part entirely at their own risk and neither the West of Yore Hunt nor the landowner accepts any responsibility for any accident loss or damage to horse, pony, any other animal, rider, spectator, vehicle or property.
- All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- We have been invited to hold this pleasure ride with the kind permission from Swinton Estates and local farmers who operate working farms with crops and livestock. Please respect the area by staying to the set route only. Follow the map and arrows along the route but if you do encounter any difficulties please call Sarah Dickinson 07880 741156.
- Please pass livestock on or near the track with care. Much of the livestock will have young at foot and some Ewes will be about to lamb.
- Riders will be asked to fill in contact details and sign a disclaimer before setting out.

To ensure that we all have a fun day without any "hiccups" please can you take note of the information and follow the rules set out below:-

Potential risks / hazards present

Livestock

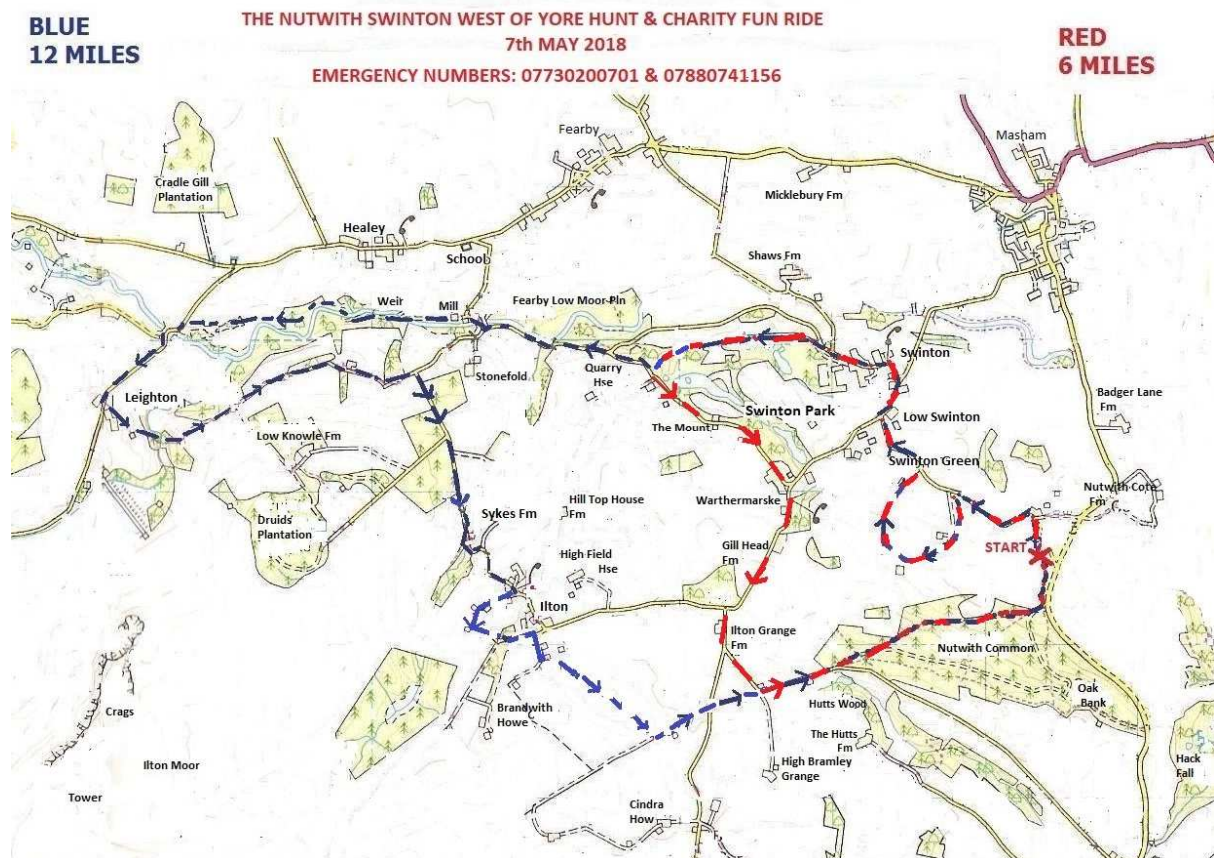
There may be cattle and sheep grazing in a number of the fields along our route, some of which may be obscured by hedges. Please be mindful of this when deciding when to trot / canter as some sheep will be with very young lambs or about to lamb. If they are on or close to the track, please pass slowly and carefully.

Walkers and dogs

In the event that you meet walkers with dogs along the way, please be courteous and return to a walk until past a safe distance.

Other riders

There may be a possibility that your path may cross with other riders so please return to a walk until past a safe distance.
