SHOW JUMPING NOTICE

PLEASE NOTE ALL SHOW JUMPING CLASSES IN RING TWO WILL RUN AS SINGLE PHASE.

RULES RELATING TO BS & SHOWING

This Show is affiliated to British Showjumping (BS), Equifest, The Veteran Horse Society, The Showing Register (TSR) & CHAPS UK

BS: DRAWN ORDER DECLARATIONS: Jumping Classes 102 (Accumulator) and 103 (Area Trial) must be made to the Declarations Steward in the Horse Secretary's Tent at least 1 hour before the advertised start of the Class.

Entries in Classes 102, 103, 202,203,204,205 & 206 are confined to registered horses, ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79.

Please note all prize money will be awarded in line with rule 76.6.

EQUIFEST: This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground in August 2018. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

TSR Regional Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots Championships - With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See www.britishshowhorse.org

Veteran Horse Society – AREA QUALIFIER 2018: First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2018, Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Open Championships, 28th – 30th September 2018. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

HORSE SHOW CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All times shown in this schedule are for guidance only and classes may start later than stated depending on previous class sizes. Please watch progress in your Ring!

ALL CUPS MUST BE RETURNED AT LEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE NEXT SHOW, WHICH WILL BE HELD ON 14th September 2019.

1- Every Competitor must wear correct riding costume. For all ridden classes this must include protective headgear, adhering to either PAS015 or (BS) EN1384 double marked with another standard such as Snell or PAS015, which must be worn and fastened at all times whilst mounted.

2- All in-hand competitors under the age of 14 are required to wear protective headgear, adhering to either PAS015 or (BS) EN1384 double marked with another standard such as Snell or PAS015, whilst exhibiting in the show rings.

3- Horses must keep to designated areas only.

4- Horse passports to be carried at all times.

5- Each Exhibitor shall be solely responsible for any consequential or other loss, injury, or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal exhibited by him and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Henley & District Agricultural Association Limited in respect thereof as aforesaid.

6- Neither the Association nor any of its officers or servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstance whatsoever to any persons, or exhibitors, or their servants or to any animal or article exhibited, or property brought into the Showground or otherwise for anything else in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the Association's Show, or these or any other conditions or regulations prescribed by the Association in relation thereto.

7- Entry fee refunds – All competitors unable to attend may apply for a 50% refund of entry fees. A 75% refund may be claimed ONLY where a valid Veterinary Certificate is produced. All refunds must be requested in writing to the Show Office or Entries Secretary, no later than 14 days from the date of show. In order to qualify for a refund all badges and passes MUST be returned, un-used.

8- Vehicle passes are for horseboxes or vehicles transporting light trade carriages ONLY. Private cars carrying spectators/grooms/extra equipment and tack etc must park in the public car park.

9- The Judge's decision is final.

10- All Exhibitors agree to pay the First Aid Contribution of £3 per rider/handler.

11- Ticket allocations are as follows:

1st Horse or pony =2 people passes (one rider plus one driver/groom)

Additional Horse/Pony = 1 people pass per additional animal

Additional Rider/Handler = 1 people pass per additional competitor

1 vehicle pass will be issued per 3 animals entered unless valid reasons are given

NB **For light trade class**, 1 extra vehicle pass and/or people pass may be requested.

For LR and FR classes, 1 extra people pass will be allocated per pony.

Extra passes may be purchased via the entry forms or on the show website.

THE VEHICLE PASSES DO NOT ADMIT THE DRIVER OR OTHER OCCUPANTS.

EACH PASSENGER NOT IN POSSESSION OF A PEOPLE PASS WILL BE CHARGED ENTRANCE FEES AS PER ADVERTISED PRICING. RANDOM VEHICLE CHECKS WILL BE PERFORMED.

The above conditions shall expressly apply to all horses and those in charge of them within the showground and its car parks.

Cars and Vehicles: No responsibility is accepted for cars or other vehicles and/or their contents left in the Official Car Park, on the Showground, or elsewhere, before, during or after the Show at any time.

Monday 3rd September 2018

NB – postal entries must be postmarked on or before Friday 31st August to be accepted.

ENTRIES ON THE DAY - due to the requirement for a box pass for entry to the showground, on the day entries can ONLY be additional entries for those competitors who have pre-entered and received a horse box pass.
