2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. The Organisers reserve the right to alter any part of the Schedule or to refuse entries without stating the reasons.
4. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs.
5. Please read all rules for Pony Club Dressage/Dengie in the 2019 Pony Club Dressage Rule Book or Dengie Qualifiers WLDR 2018/19 Rules on the Pony Club web site www.pcuk.org. A copy of the Rule Book will be held with the Secretary on the day of the competition.
6. Any objection should be made in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. After due consideration of the objection, the judge's decision is final.
7. Once times are published, there will be **NO REFUND** of any entry fees, unless your place can be filled.
8. Securely fastened hard hats must be worn at all times by everyone when mounted. Hats should be tagged and must conform to Pony Club Rules 2019. All hats to be checked when collecting numbers. Dark blue, black or brown hats only.
9. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class.
10. Horses or ponies must be over four years old on the day of the competition.
11. No galloping anywhere on the showground, riders must only walk their horses/ponies in the car park. **No lungeing** on show ground.
12. Dogs must be on leads at all times.


