

Rules

- No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees
- Correct and safe dress must be worn at all times – Pony Club members must wear hard hats (with PC hat tag) that comply with current BHS Standards PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark or the Snell E2001 (full list of standards on display in the clubhouse)
- Riders age as at 01.01.2018
- No horse or pony to be left unattended tied to a lorry or trailer
- Horse muck/hay/rubbish should be removed from the car/lorry park and placed on the muck heap or in bins provided
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times. Please collect and dispose appropriately of any dog muck immediately
- Where photographer in attendance – please notify if you do not want you/your child to be photographed
- THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL
- ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED ONLY ON THE ASSUMPTION THAT EXHIBITORS HAVE READ AND AGREE TO THESE RULES AND STATEMENTS BELOW, AND WHICH ARE ALSO POSTED IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Legal Liability

Non Pony Club competitors are not covered by the Pony Club Insurance and must have their own third party cover. Amman Valley & District Branch of the Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non- members and their insurance will not cover you.

Health & Safety

- A riding hat must be worn and be correctly fastened at all times when riding and is strongly advised for when handling horses/ponies on the ground.
- Non-members are strongly advised to wear a hat that complies with Pony Club standards.
- The event organisers have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable measures to avoid and prevent accidents.
