

Rules of Entry

1. Appropriate dress must be worn; hard hats must comply with current BSI standards.
Hats must be worn at ALL times when mounted.
2. Pony Club Rules apply.
3. The Judge's decision is final.
4. The Organisers and Burrows Court accept no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, grooms, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
5. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel a class, withhold a prize or disqualify a competitor for any reason they deem necessary.
6. No refunds will be made.
7. Horses/ponies must not be left tied to lorries/trailers and left unattended.
8. Please make sure all droppings etc are removed before leaving. No mucking out.
9. Horses must be 4 years old and over.
10. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leads at all times and cleared up after.
11. No lungeing.
12. All children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
13. Whips and callers ARE permitted.
14. By entering a class a competitor is agreeing to abide by the rules.

Rules for Novice Winter League Dressage

Open to all Pony Club Branch and Centre Members that fulfil the following criteria:

Riders are not eligible:

1. If they have represented a Branch or Centre at Open Area Dressage or above (this includes summer and/or winter Area Competitions)

2. Preliminary Rounds - If they have won any BD (or DI) points at Novice level or above
Please also refer to Dengie Dressage Rules 2018/2019 General Rules Applicable to all Levels.

Class 5: Intermediate - PC Intermediate Dressage Test 2013

Rules for Intermediate Winter League Dressage

Eligibility: Open to all Pony Club Branch and Centre Members that fulfil the following criteria:

Combination of horse and rider are not eligible:

1. If they have represented a Branch or Centre at Open Area Dressage or above (this includes summer and/or winter Area Competitions)

2. If they have won BD (or DI) points at Elementary level or above, or competed at Medium level
Please also refer to Dengie Dressage Rules 2018/2019 General Rules Applicable to all Levels.

Class 6: Open League Qualifier - PC Open Dressage Test 2015

Rules for Open Winter League Dressage:

Eligibility: Open to all Pony Club Branch and Centre Members. Horses which have won more than 10 points at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year are not eligible.

This includes Hors Concours entries. Please also refer to Dengie Dressage Rules 2018/2019 General Rules Applicable to all Levels.

Competitors may qualify a maximum of three horses for the Area Competition. Horses may be ridden by up to two different riders at a Preliminary Round.

This Competition will be run under 2018 Pony Club Dressage Rules - www.pcuk.org

Classes 4 to 6 will additionally be run under Dengie Dressage Rules 2018/2019

- Entries close on Monday 28th January 2019, entries will not be accepted without payment.
