Class 8 – 90cm

Rosettes: Awarded 1st – 6th place in each class
(Each section in classes 1 – 3)

Special rosette: to highest placed over 60yr old rider

Jumping: will be run as single phase under current BS club rules.

Jumps are restricted to a maximum height of 50cm in the indoor arena.

For the classes above this height, you will be allowed some time before your round starts to jump some larger fences in the outdoor arena.

Classes 5 – 8: The 7 highest placed Junior and 7 highest placed Senior combinations will qualify from each Show Jumping Qualifier for the Trailblazers Championship Finals 2025.

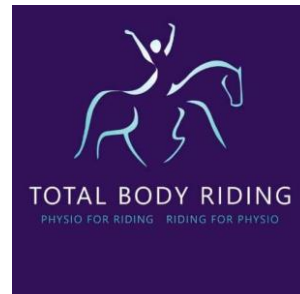

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard PAS 015 (2011) or VG1, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
2. Long hair should be worn in a net or secured in such a way as not to hang lower than the shoulder line.
3. Gloves are compulsory for dressage
4. A horse or pony may compete from 1 Jan in the year that it becomes 4 years old.
5. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information. In the event of cancellation all fees will be refunded less 15%
6. Unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident and emergency callout
7. Entry fees are non-refundable unless an official doctor note or vet report is sent to the organiser
8. The judges decision is final both in the warm up and competition
