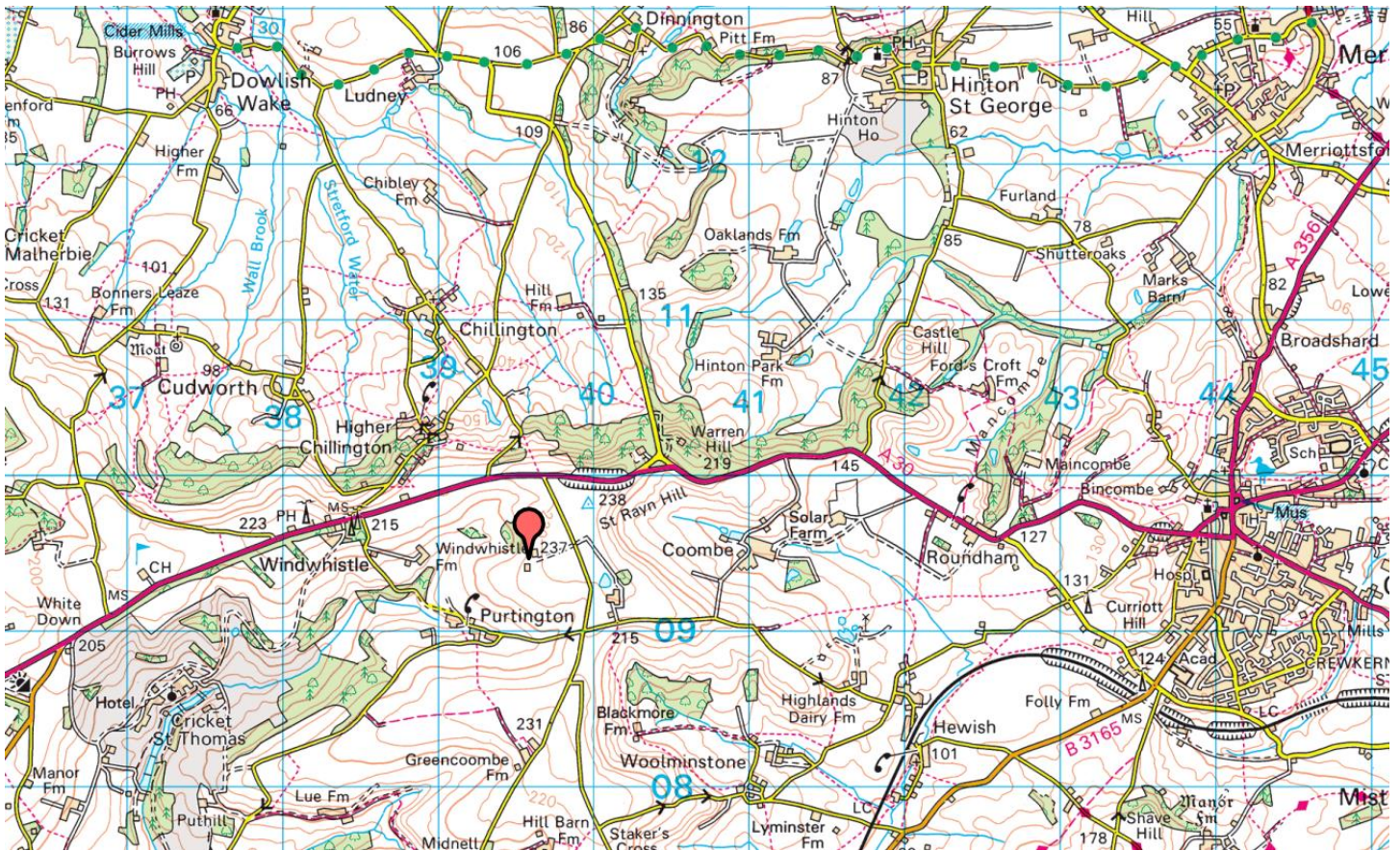

From the North

Leave M5 at Junction 25 and follow A358 to Chard. After the B&Q store traffic lights take the 1st left signposted Cricket St Thomas. At the Tesco roundabout take the A30 to Crewkerne. Follow the road for approx. 4 miles past the Cricket St Thomas Golf Club & the Windwhistle Inn.

There is a large lay-by on the left and a turning right signposted Chard Equestrian Centre and Wayford & Winsham. Turn right and after ¼ mile down the lane, the showground entrance is on your right.

From the West

Leave Exeter on the A30, after Honiton stay on the A30 towards Chard. Go straight through the town of Chard. At the Tesco roundabout take the A30 to Crewkerne. Follow the road for approx. 4 miles past the Cricket St Thomas Golf Club & the Windwhistle Inn.

There is a large lay-by on the left and a turning right signposted Chard Equestrian Centre and Wayford & Winsham. Turn right and after ¼ mile down the lane, the showground entrance is on your right.

From the East

Drive through Crewkerne town centre and take the A30 out of town signposted to Chard. Drive through Roundham and after two kilometres, the turning for Chard Equestrian Centre will be on your left.

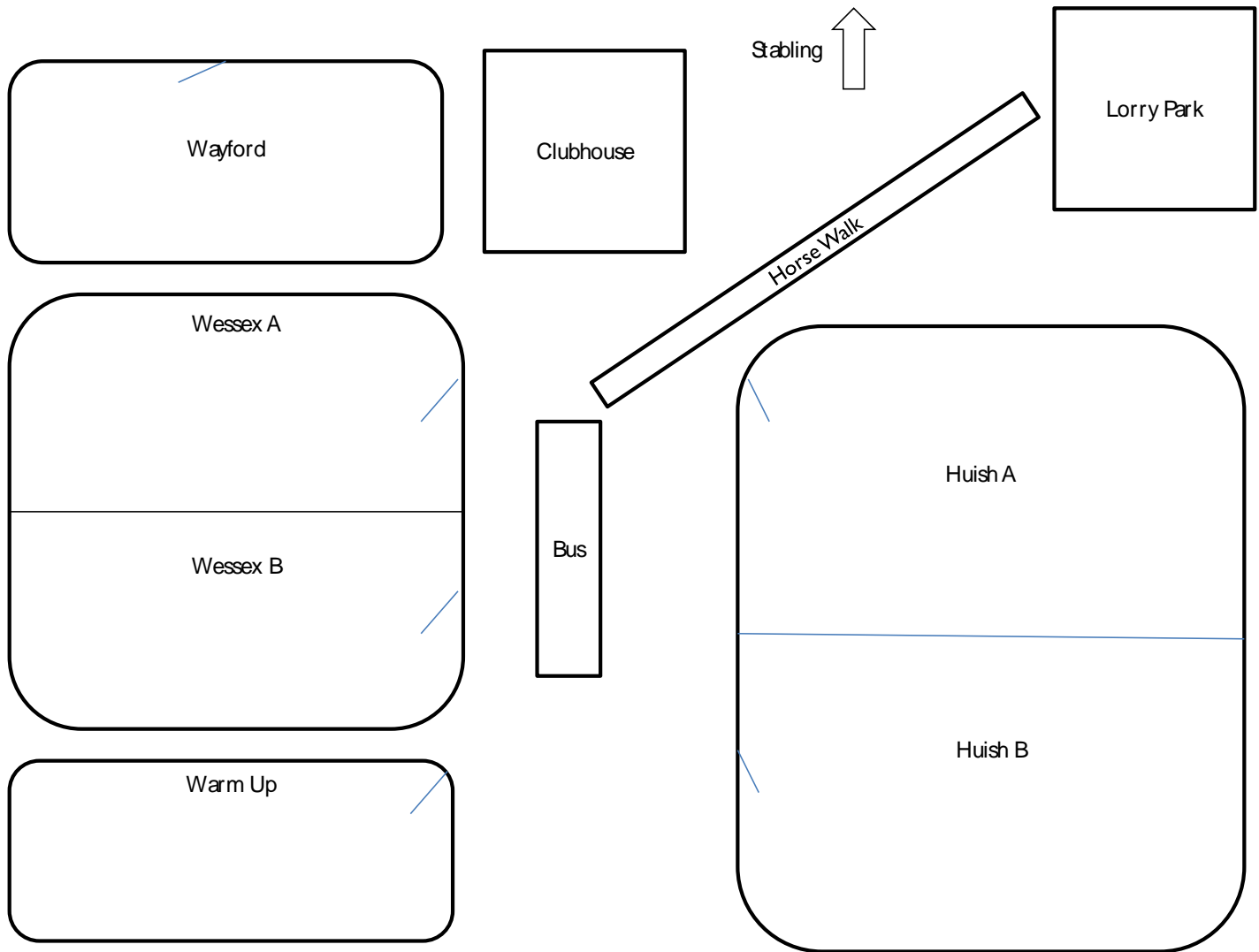
Stables 10 × 12 feet are available for rent either on show days or for the nights before and after events.

SOCIETY AFFILIATIONS

CHAPS

This Show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). **Affiliation No. 24-033**
Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need NOT be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualifier card. Members to apply in to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 15th - 17th August 2024. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com. Only "coloured" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members' Handbook) may compete in these classes.

All stallions, 4 yrs old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK).

All stallions must wear Stallion ID discs in the ring without exception.

Rising Star Ridden Show Hunter: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. The two highest placed unqualified will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Series Final at the BSHA National Championships Show September 2024.

Rising Star Ridden Show Cob: Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Exhibits to be shown hogged. The two highest placed unqualified will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Series Final at the BSHA National Championships Show September 2024.

Rising Star Racehorse to Show Horse: Mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cm. Open to thoroughbred horses retired from race training. The two highest placed unqualified will qualify for the Rising Star Associate Series Final at the BSHA National Championships Show September 2024. This class is open to competitors who work within the racing industry.

RIDDEN: THE IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE SOCIETY (GB) £2000 RIDDEN CHALLENGE

Open to Irish Draught and Irish Draught Sport Horses, Hunters, Cobs, Working Hunter and Riding Horse classes at shows affiliated to the SHB (GB) and BSHA. Horses must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding

IN HAND: THE MOORBENNHALL IRISH DRAUGHT YOUNGSTOCK CHALLENGE – Classes 24 and 58

Open to Pure bred Irish Draught Youngstock (1, 2 and 3 year old) Hunter Youngstock classes are also eligible (if a pure bred Irish Draught has been entered).

THE IDHS(GB) SPORT HORSE YOUNGSTOCK CHALLENGE – Classes 25 and 58

Open to Irish Draught Sport Horse Youngstock (1, 2 and 3 year old) Classes can award qualifiers. Hunter Youngstock classes are also eligible (must have minimum of 25% proven ID breeding)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES:

- All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register. All yearling, two and three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three year old colts must be un-inspected.
- Stallions (In hand or ridden) must also be inspected and over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) All RIDDEN Pure bred Irish Draughts must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership.
- All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over. All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.
- **All owners of Pure Bred Irish Draught horses MUST be full members of the IDHS (GB).**
- All Irish Draught Sport Horse Breeding and Youngstock In Hand exhibits must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. All yearling, two and three year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three year old colts must be un-inspected.
- All **RIDDEN** Irish Draught Sport Horses must be in the correct ownership, have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.
- **Owners of Irish Draught Sport Horses DO NOT have to be members of the IDHS (GB)**
- This show is a qualifier for the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge. The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each of the following classes (**32, 33, 34 & 35**) that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Register, with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 7th & 8th September 2024 at Onley Equestrian Centre, Onley Grounds Farm, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ. In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money and a trophy. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500, and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50. A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Qualifiers will be contacted by a member of the IDHS Show Team. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhs.gb.org.uk to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the final.

This show is a qualifier for the **British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series**

The 2 highest-placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 30 and 31 will qualify for the final to be held at the **Royal International Horse Show Hickstead, on July 26th (provisional) 2025**. Qualification can be passed to 3rd place if the highest-placed horses have already qualified and if in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality.

- Purebred Irish Draught horses must be registered with or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB). Purebred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or over-stamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class 1 Class 2, or RID(GB).

- Irish Draught Sport Horses (including stallions) must have a **minimum** of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. Owners **do not** have to be members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB)
- All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over

Class 38 TATTERSALLS ROR OPEN IN HAND SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2025

Open to all RoR and NR **competition registered** horses, 3yrs and over, mares, fillies and geldings. Handlers must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the class. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a bitless/In-Hand Bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at The RoR National Championships at Aintree, August 2025. RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a branded prize to the winner. The prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Competitors placed 1st and 2nd in Class 38 qualify for Championship 2

Class 39 TATTERSALLS ROR AMATEUR RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2025

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1st January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series. The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final. Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. **The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting, June 2025.** RoR rosettes 1st – 4th and a RoR branded prize to the winner to be redeemed from the RoR Office. **The winner also qualifies** for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2025. A branded prize will be presented to the highest placed Veteran horse (15+) and qualification to the RoR Ridden Veteran Final also at Aintree, August 2025. Prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office.

Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage(d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st 2023. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW QUALIFYING CLASSES

All Hunter Classes will be judged under the Society's 2024 Rules. **Classes 40 and 42 - 47** are qualifying events for the **2025 RIHS** and only horses registered on the Show Hunter Register are eligible to enter. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry forms and owners and riders must be members of the Society. The two highest placed horses in each class will qualify to enter at the RIHS.

DAY TICKETS & SHOW TICKETS Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets and two Show Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider, and Open Affiliated classes only, but will NOT allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. A Show Ticket has the same criteria and covers all days of a Show running for longer than one day. Horses registered on a Day / Show Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day / Show Ticket by applying online on the BSHA website. Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

BSHA SUPREME OF THE YEAR The highest placed unqualified exhibit in the top 5 in each Open Affiliated class will qualify to compete in the BSHA Supreme of Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA National Championship Shows in September 2024. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes)

- The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to Grand Finals, unless special circumstances should arise, then it will be left to the discretion of the Directors and Advisory Committee to oversee this rule if required.

DIRECT ROUTE QUALIFIERS are **open** to Members and Non-members **however**, to claim the LIHS ticket a competitor **must** already be a 2024 member. The member **must** produce the membership card or a covering letter from the SSADL Show office to be able to claim the LIHS Ticket. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same for the Grand Final, unless under special circumstances, then the Directors will intervene.

For a competitor to be eligible to compete at the LIHS Senior Showing Grand Final at the ExCel, all ponies/horses **MUST** meet the current FEI Vaccination Regulations.

NB: ONCE A COMPETITOR HAS QUALIFIED FOR LIHS IN THE RIDDEN SECTION, THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO QUALIFY IN THE IN-HAND SECTION AND VICE VERSA.

A competitor/member can still compete in qualifiers but are not allowed in any Championship. Should this arise the 2nd & 3rd will go forward to the show day Championship

- No Spurs- with the exception to Adult Side Saddle Riders - No Galloping/Canter Extensions
- No wearing of Face/Body Jewellery, with the exception to a medical earring.
- No Foals are permitted in SSADL classes
- In Hand classes: Minimum age of handler = 11yrs
- Stallions: Either In-Hand or Ridden competitors must be over the age of 16 years.
- Grooms must be 16 years of age and over and correctly dressed.
- Lead Rein competitors will not be required to strip
- First ridden ponies will only canter in their individual show
- SSADL age badges must be worn by members, Failure to do so will render disqualification.
- All stallions must wear the SSADL Stallion badge
- Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given.
- The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same whether side saddle or astride from first/second or direct route qualifiers and grand final.

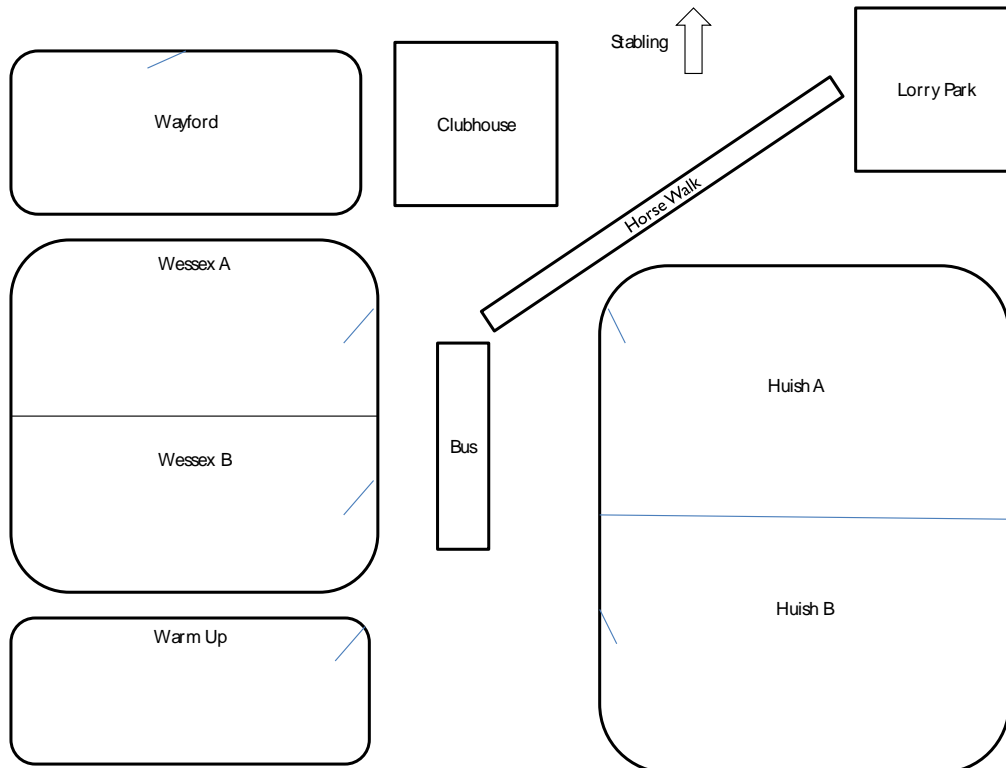

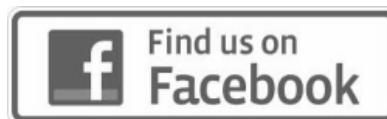
