The riding on the South Downs is excellent, with many miles of bridleways for you to explore, offering you some of the most spectacular views in the South East.

You can either download a pre-mapped route from OS Maps or create your own, either way you choose how far and at what speed you want to ride. You can even take part in an all-day ride where we will meet you en-course with refreshments for you and your horse.

The facilities at Plumpton Racecourse include airy outdoor stables for your horse and a dedicated camping area for you.

The price of £400 for camping represents exceptional value and includes, breakfast, lunch and evening meals, stabling with bedding and hay.

Informal evening lectures and activities are also included subject of which is still to be confirmed.

How about a bit of extra pampering? You can also treat you and/or your horse to some relaxing Bowen Therapy* with Pennie Clayton.

The emphasis of this break will be on a relaxed, welcoming atmosphere where you can cone and enjoy some special time away with your horse.

Please return your form and copies of your horse's passport and vaccination card.

(This camp is for over 18`s only).

A deposit of £50.00 is payable upon booking. This is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Full balance of £450 for a room/ £400 for camping, plus any additional items you have booked is required by 31 May 2024. If not received it will be presumed that you no longer wish to attend and your place will be given to someone else.

Cancellation:

60 or more days prior to camp: full refund less deposit Between 31-59 days prior to camp: 50% refund less deposit 30 days or less prior to camp: no refund

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, in which case a full refund will be given or the opportunity to transfer to the following year.

The organisers are not liable for any adverse weather conditions (for example, but not limited to, heat/rain/wind) that may affect the camp.

The organisers advise you take out holiday insurance that covers you in the case of having to cancel your place at camp due to COVID-19, or any other unforeseen circumstances.

COVID 19 at Plumpton Racecourse; The Racecourse will take all reasonable precautions to manage the spread of COVID 19, and would ask guest to abide by their policies and any Government guidance's in place at the time of your booking,

Whilst hard hats are not mandatory by law, for the purpose of this camp all riders are to wear a hard hat to conforming to current British standards when mounted.

Body protectors are advised for Show Jumping.

All riders MUST have adequate insurance to cover any incident that may be caused by them or their animals (minimum third party).

Neither the organisers nor the owners of the facilities will be held responsible for any loss, damage or expense incurred to any person, property or animal at the event.

A copy of your horse's passport and vaccination record must be sent by email when you return your booking form. The college rules are that **horses must have been vaccinated no more than 6 months prior to the last day of camp and no less than 7 days before attending camp (for clarity horses will need to have been vaccinated between 28th January and 17th July to attend camp)**. These terms are subject to change by Plumpton College.

The organisers reserve the right to ask a participant or spectator to leave the premises at any time.

The camp is open to any rider/handler over the age of 18.

No dogs.

The racecourse do not have the facilities for turn out.
