Rules:

- 1. This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020.
- 2. The decision of the Judges, Organisers and Jury is final. They reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition, or refuse entry without stating a reason.
- 3. In the event of cancellation, the entry fee less £15 to cover administration costs, will be refunded on receipt of a SAE by 7th July 2020.
- 4. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 5. HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY. Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- 6. HATS meeting current Pony Club standards MUST be worn at all times when mounted. All hats must be correctly fitted and tagged with a current Pony Club, British Eventing or Riding Club tag.
- 7. BODY PROTECTORS, which are up to the current Pony Club standard (as in the 2020 Rule Book) are recommended for Show Jumping and are compulsory for Cross Country. Competitors wearing body cages MUST leave the key with the Secretary before they go Cross Country. If a rider chooses to wear an air jacket, it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector and in the event of a fall it must be removed or deflated before continuing.
- 8. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £25 which will only be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 9. No horse / pony may compete more than once.
- 10. Stallions may only be ridden by members with written permission from their District Commissioner and must wear an identification disc on their bridle.
- 11. Competitors must present themselves to the steward for tack inspection at least 20 minutes before their dressage time.
- 12. Competitors who are eliminated in the Show Jumping may only go Cross Country with the permission of the Official Steward.
- 13. INSURANCE Non Pony Club competitors are not covered by the Pony Club insurance and must have their own cover. This must be a minimum of third party cover.
- 14. There will not be a farrier on site.

Dogs must be kept on leads AT ALL TIMES
