- 3. In the event of cancellation, entry fees less £10 to cover administration costs per rider, will be refunded by 14th July 2020.
- 4. Entry Fees will only be refunded up to the closing date, 5th June 2020. After this date we will make a refund on receipt of a doctor or vet certificate if we can fill the place from a wait list.
- 5. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 6. HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY. Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. - 9. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organisers within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £20 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 10. NO STALLIONS
- 11. No cantering outside the rings and warm up areas.
- 12. All dogs must be on a short lead at all times. Please kindly clear up after your dog.
- 13. There will not be a farrier on site.
- 14. Please ensure non Pony Club members have their own insurance.
