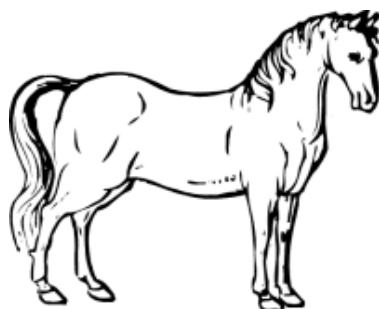


Hallamshire Riding Society of Sheffield

Class 2 09.30 am Nursery Showing Class Pony to be ridden by a child at the very beginning of their showing career,
Children 5 years and under. Walk only is required, trot is optional in a display. To be led by an attendant, in any suitable bridle. There may be two attendants per child. Rosettes all round.

Class 3 10.00 am Lead Rein Pony. Mare or gelding, n/e 12.2 hh
4 y.o and over. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Riders 8 years and under.
Lead Rein to be fastened to noseband only.

Class 4 10.30 am Just off the lead rein. Ponies 4 y.o. and over not exceeding 13.2 hh and to be ridden by a child 8 years and under
No lead reins in the ring, but an attendant may walk alongside in the ring as if on the lead rein and offer help with brakes and steering. Short display will be required, walk and trot on both reins, any suitable bit / bridle. Rosettes all round!
