Please send a screenshot to confirm when payment made. Please use reference 'show' plus your name. No entries on the day. Times will be emailed/texted on Fri 18th September.

Please follow social distancing and hand hygiene rules at all times on the day. The club hut will be closed to competitors. Hats to current BRC standards must be worn at all times when mounted.

### Club Rules

All competitors in ridden classes <u>must</u> wear hats complying with the new BRC standard for 2016 onwards for safety and insurance reasons. Hats bearing **only** the EN1384 or BSEN1384 standard will no longer be accepted under BHS hat rules for 2016. However, hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and another standard such as:

- PAS 015 (1998 or 2011)
- VG1 01.040 (2014-12)
- ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards)
- SNELL E2001 or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards)
- 1. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 2.Wearing of riding hats and chin straps to the current BSI standard is compulsory when mounted. Suitable attire to be worn in all rings. From January 2016 onwards, BRC will not accept the EN1384 nor BSEN1384 standard for riding hats unless they are combined with a further standard and a kite mark. Also hats with peaks cannot be worn X country from then. Covers and silks will be allowed.
- 3.The Committee and Organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident, loss or damage to competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or property for any reason.
- $4. The \ Committee \ have \ the \ right \ to \ refuse \ admission \ to \ the \ show ground \ to \ any \ horse \ or \ person \ for \ any \ reason.$
- 5.Membership must be fully paid up before benefiting from discounted class prices.
- 6. Junior riders must have attained their 3rd birthday on day of show.
- 7. Any horse or pony competing in riding events must be 4 years of age or over in the current year and must be of sound condition.
- 8.No stallions are allowed at club events. Colts (up to one year old) may be brought with an adult handler.
- 9.The Committee reserve the right to measure any horse or pony and to request a height certificate where any height is in dispute. In the event of such action being taken and the animal is found to be of incorrect height, the said animal will be disqualified from the class in question until a height measurement certificate to the contrary has been produced.
- 10.Excessive use of the whip and/or spurs in any class will result in elimination. No whips over 30 inches permitted in any showing class. Spurs must be blunt, turned downwards and not inwards.
- 11.In Lead Rein or First Ridden classes, ponies must be shown in suitable bits and bridles.
- 12.Riders must not gallop or canter anywhere on the showground except in the warming up area or in the rings. Offenders will be asked to leave the showground without refund of entry money.
- 13.It is the competitor's responsibility to enter the ring when asked to do so. Failure to comply may lead to elimination from the class unless the ring steward has been informed of the circumstances.
- 14.Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
- 15.Litter must not be dropped.
- 16.Entry fees cannot be returned except at the discretion of the Show Secretary.
- 17. The decision of the judge is final. Arguing with the judge or general abusive behaviour on the showground will invite elimination.
- 18.Any objection/complaint must be put in writing and handed to the Show Secretary not more than one hour after the class and must be accompanied by £20. If the objection/complaint is found to be justified by the Committee at their next meeting the £20 will be refunded.
- 19. The Committee reserve the right to alter the programme or to consolidate classes or abandon classes. Also to amend or add to these rules as they feel necessary.
- 20. Non-members competing at the show must hold their own up to date 3rd party insurance
- 21. All equines must have up to date flu vaccinations (booster within 12 months of show date)

#### COVID RULES

- 22. Social distancing rules must be followed at all times whilst on the showground. Stay 2m apart from anyone outside your household!
- 23. Wear gloves or practise hand hygiene after touching field and arena gates.
- $24. \ Maximum\ 4\ horses\ in\ the\ show\ ring\ at\ any\ one\ time.\ Larger\ classes\ will\ be\ split\ or\ run\ in\ two\ sections.$
- 25. The club hut will be shut and no refreshments will be available on the day.
- 26. All entries and payment in advance only.. We will text or Email start times for your class.(es)
- 27. Please do not arrive more than one hour before your class is due to start.
- 28. Park lorries and trailers at least 3 metres apart.
- 29. Please do not bring more helpers than necessary.
- 30. Do not stand around the arena watching other competitors.
- 31. When you have finished your classes please load up and leave promptly to keep numbers on the field to a minimum.
- 32. All non-members must have completed and returned their BRC Covid form and declaration in advance of the show.
