Selected classes are qualifiers for Equifest and Veteran Horse Society but are open to all competitors

All competitors must also pay a Compulsory Fee of £2 per Show for First Aid cover

New Members are welcome to join on the day.

Section Championships

Supreme Championship

Each show is affiliated to <u>Equifest</u>, taking place at the East of England Show on the 19th

August – 22nd August 2020. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each

affiliated class will qualify.

Qualifier cards are the responsibility of the exhibitor; these must be available for the Judge, Steward or Show Secretary to sign. For details on how to affiliate and receive your free card please see contact details at the end of this schedule.

19TH July & 23rd August classes 10 & 21 are also <u>Veteran Horse Society</u> area qualifiers – Open to members and non-members of the VHS. All competitors placed 1st- 4th in each age category will qualify for VHS Regional Finals.

RING 2 - RIDDEN CLASSES - starts at 10am

- 1. BEST TURNED OUT HORSE/PONY AND RIDER a) Lead Rein, b) Non Lead Rein
- 2. NOVICE RIDDEN Horse/pony or Rider a) Lead Rein b) Non Lead Rein
- 3. BEST RIDING HORSE Over 14.2hh

<u>NupaFeed / EQUIFEST Riding Horse -</u> Open show Riding Horse, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, any Height, rider any age. Classes may be divided as follows - Small Riding Horse exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 158cms / Large Riding Horse exceeding 158cm.

4. BEST RIDING PONY - 14.2hh and under a) Lead Rein, b) Non Lead Rein

The Milner Family – EQUIFEST Show Pony Lead Rein – Ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cm. Lead Rein Riders not to have obtained their 8th birthday before the first of January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein must be attached to the noseband.

The Coles Show Team / EQUIFEST Show Pony First Ridden Showing - Ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the first of January in the current year.

Broadbandandphones.co.uk / EQUIFEST Ridden Show Ponies- Open to Show Pony, mare, or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cm. Riders not to have obtained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows: not exceeding 128cm - riders not to have obtained their 13th birthday before the 1st January in the current year, exceeding 128cm but not exceeding 138cm - riders not to have obtained their 15th birthday before the 1st January in the current year, exceeding 138cm but not exceeding 148cm - riders not to have obtained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

- **6.** RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND Open to Lead Rein (class may be split depending on entries)

 Cavernoma Alliance UK EQUIFEST Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein Open to M&M ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding 4 years or over, not exceeding 128 cm. Riders not to have attained the 9^h birthday before the first of January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein must be attached to the noseband.

 EQUIFEST Mountain and Moorland First Ridden Open to M&M registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained the 12^h birthday before the first of January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

 EQUIFEST Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Open to M&M registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4
- 7. RIDDEN COB Traditional or Hogged

years or over. Rider any age.

<u>NupaFeed / EQUIFEST Ridden Cobs</u> - Open ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. - Open LW Ridden Cob, mare or gelding exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cm - Open HW Ridden Cob, mare or gelding exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cm.

EQUIFEST Maxi Cobs - Open Maxi Cob, mare or gelding exceeding 155cm, to be judged as cobs. Rider any age.

- 8. RIDDEN COLOURED Open to piebald, skewbald, palomino, dun and appaloosa

 Open to Lead Rein (class may be split depending on entries)

 BSPA / EQUIFEST Ridden Piebald / Skewbald Horse or Pony Open to piebald & skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA championships, subject to their show rules and conditions.
- **9. BEST RIDING CLUB TYPE Horse or pony** a) Lead Rein, b) Non Lead Rein. To include a small individual show and a small jump(s) Lead rein will be trotting poles
- 10. RIDDEN VETERAN Open to Lead Rein and the class may be split depending on entries. Horse or pony, to exceed 15 years in age VHS Qualifier 19th July & 23rd August

RING 2 – WORKING HUNTER CLASSES

- 11. BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER PONY To include lead rein Max. Height 40cm
- 12. NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE, PONY OR RIDER* Max. Height 60cm
- 13. INTERMEDIATE WORKING HUNTER HORSE AND PONY * Approx. Height 80cm
- 14. OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE AND PONY * Approx. Height 90cm

Working Hunter Championship - 1st and 2nd places from classes 11-14 eligible

* Classes 12 - 14 may be split into separate horse and pony classes if entries warrant.

Working Hunter Classes to be judged on jumping performance, conformation, type, presence and manners. All horses and ponies to be 4 years old and over

<u>Spillers / EQUIFEST Mountain & Moorland In Hand</u> - Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

- 19. COB Traditional or Hogged
- **20. COLOURED** Open to piebald, skewbald, palomino, dun and appaloosa

 <u>BSPA / EQUIFEST In Hand Piebald / Skewbald</u> Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions.
- 21. VETERAN Horse or pony, to exceed 15 years in age VHS Qualifier 19th July & 23rd August
- 22. BONNIEST PONY/HORSE

In Hand Championship - 1st and 2nd places from classes 15-22 eligible

Members must have competed at 3 shows during the season to be eligible to win these trophies at the presentation night (dressage on 13th September also counts as a show). Non-members may enter these classes but they won't be eligible to win the trophies.

PLEASE CHECK THE WEBSITE AND SECRETARYS CABIN ON SHOW DAY FOR ANY SCHEDULE AMENDMENTS. *PLEASE READ THE EQUIFEST & VETERAN HORSE SOCIETY QUALIFIER INFORMATION SHEET IN THE CABIN ON SHOW DAY OR THE SCHEDULE ON THE WEBSITE DETAILING HOW THE QUALIFIER CLASSES WORK*

- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to all events and be available for inspection. Horses must be vaccinated in accordance with BRC rules http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/news
- All classes are open to MEMBERS & NON MEMBERS, only MEMBERS will gain points towards annual awards
- If you have more than one horse or pony you must nominate one of them at the start of the season for Club points. You can however enter any of the classes you are eligible for on any other horse or pony. You will not gain Club points but will be eligible for place rosettes on the day. You can change your Club horse/pony only once during the season and carry your points across but you can't then change back or transfer your points to a third horse/pony
- For all TRC events the age for all the year is at 1st January 2020
- All Lead Rein competitors must be 4 years old by the date of the first show and under 8 years of age. Lead
 Rein competitors are not allowed in any Show Jumping classes, and they must remain on Lead Rein at all
 times whilst on the show ground
- Entry money will not be refunded once the entry has been made
- Hats must be worn to at least this standard with harnesses properly adjusted and fastened:
 British PAS015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked, VG1 01.040 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked. European VG 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked. American ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked, SNELL E2001 or Snell E2016. Australian & New Zealand AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked
- Skull cap hats must be worn with a silk
- Jackets must be worn in all jumping classes at all times
- Any complaint must be lodged at the Secretary's cabin with the payment of £10, which will be refunded should the objection not be sustained
- The decision of the judges will be final
- No entries taken once the class has commenced
- The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry
- Any competitor not ready when called may be eliminated
- Classes may be split or amalgamated depending on entries
- PLEASE NOTE LUNGEING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE SHOW FIELD
 Please make sure you have adequate insurance cover for your horse/pony
