<b>Class 2: BD Intro A (2008)</b>	20m x 40m arena
<b>Class 3: BD Prelim 14 (2006)</b>	20m x 40m arena
<b>Class 4: BE 90 Test 92 (2009)</b>	20m x 40m arena
<b>Class 5: BD Novice 30 (2006)</b>	20m x 40m arena
<b>Class 6: BD Elementary 42 (2008) or BD Medium 63 (2002)</b>	20m x 40m arena
<b>Class 7: Prelim Long Arena PYO: choose between BD P15 and P17A</b>	20m x 60m arena
<b>Class 8: Novice Long Arena PYO: choose between BD N23 and N37A</b>	20m x 60m arena
<b>Class 9: Elementary/Medium Long Arena PYO: choose between E57, E59 or M61</b>	20m x 60m arena

Classes 6, 7, 8, and 9 – results are combined for each class and placings decided based on the percentage scored. Riders can do multiple tests in each of the PYO classes (entry fee for each) but only the highest score counts towards placings.

All classes £13. Rosettes: to sixth place

Relaxed Dress code, plaiting optional.

### All tests may be called

**CLOSING DATE:** The Wednesday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held.

**TIMES:** start lists with times are posted Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of the Saturday before the competition.

**PRIZEGIVING:** class presentations will be un-mounted about 25 minutes after the end of the class by the Secretary area

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. All competitors must have their own third party cover. Please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

## **RULES AND NOTICES**

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).

2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/ email the Entries Secretary for available spaces.

3. Closing date for entries – Sunday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.) Refunds will be minus a £5 administration charge.

4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded on receipt of an s.a.e. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.

5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see the documents section of Equo Events.

6. We don't use numbers so when you arrive, simply get ready and warm up.

7. Children must not ride in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.

8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each class. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.

9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses is relaxed.

10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

11. We sometimes get withdrawals so it really helps if you can be ready to ride your test approx. 10 mins before the time shown.

12. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity.

13. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road.

**14. All classes are run under British Dressage rules.**

15. The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor behaving in such a manner as to breach these rules.

16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or alter the order of classes if there are insufficient entries.

17. Requests with regards to times can be declared in your entry notes and the organisers will do their best to accommodate these.

18. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
