## **SCHEDULE**

All Dressage Tests are in a 20x40m school. Entrants can enter multiple classes, within reason.

### **Combined Training**

Combined training competitions consist of competitors competing in two disciplines, dressage and show jumping. Run under Trailblazers Rules.

**Class 1: Intro to Combined Training** (non-qualifier): Intro Dressage (Intro A (2008)) & 50cm Show Jumping

**Class 2a: For Ponies 148cm and under:** Prelim Dressage (Prelim 1 (2006)) & 65cm Show Jumping

**Class 2b: For Horses over 148cm:** Prelim Dressage (Prelim 1 (2006)) with 65cm Show Jumping

**Class 3a: For Ponies 148cm and under:** Novice Dressage (Novice 27 (2007)) with 75cm Show Jumping

**Class 3b: For Horses over 148cm:** Novice Dressage (Novice 27 (2007)) with 75cm Show Jumping

**Class 4: For Horses over 148cm:** Elem Dressage (Elem 42 (2008)) with 85cm Show Jumping

*Please note that horses and ponies may be combined for placings if insufficient numbers. However, this will not affect qualification opportunities.*

### **Dressage**

Run under BD Rules. Trailblazers Second Round, Cricklands and Hartpury South West Championships Qualifier.

**Class 5: Intro C (2016)**

**Class 6: Prelim 13 (2006)**

**Class 7: Novice 34 (2009)**

**Class 8: Elementary 44 (2002) or Medium 71 (2002)**

*Results for Class 8 will be decided based on percentage earned. If numbers permit, the class will be split according to the test ridden.*

**Clear rounds are also available to enter on the day.**

### **Entry Fees:**

All Classes can be pre entered via Equo Events

Online Entries: Combined Training: £22

Dressage: £13

Clear round (enter on the day): £10

£3 per Competitor First Aid Charge – payable in cash on the day for those show jumping (including for Combined Training classes).

Late entries may be available if numbers permit and incur a £3 late entry charge in addition to the advanced entry fee.

Rosettes 1st – 6th and prize to winner of each class

## **TRAILBLAZERS COMBINED TRAINING RULES.**

### **Dressage**

The dressage section of the competition will be run under Trailblazers Dressage Rules unless they are over-ridden by the Trailblazers Combined Training Rules.

### **Show Jumping**

The show jumping section of the competition will be run under Trailblazers Show Jumping Rules unless they are over-ridden by the Trailblazers Combined Training Rules.

The show jumping section will be run over one round (T1).

### **Overall Winner**

The overall winner will be decided by deducting any show jumping penalties from the competitors' dressage score. In the event of equal marks, the time in the show jumping section will decide the higher placing.

### **Eligibility**

Any age of rider will be allowed to ride any height of horse or pony as long as the partnership is compatible; however, should the Judge for the competition deem the partnership incompatible, the Judge has the right to exclude the Competitor from competing in the competition. The Judge's decision is final. In such an instance, the Show Organiser would not be liable for any refund of any fees to the excluded Competitor.

A rider may compete on more than one horse / pony in any competition.

The same combination of horse / pony and rider must compete in both sections (dressage and show jumping) of the competition.

### **Competitor Dress Code**

For the dressage section, the Trailblazers Dressage Rules will apply.

For the show jumping section, the Trailblazers Show Jumping Rules will apply.

### **Tack and Equipment**

For the dressage section, the Trailblazers Dressage Rules will apply.

For the show jumping section, the Trailblazers Show Jumping Rules will apply.

### **Numbers to Qualify**

The 5 highest placed combinations, regardless of the number of starters in the qualifier, will qualify to compete at the Championship Finals.

Competitors that qualify may purchase a Qualification Card from the venue at which they have qualified. You can purchase qualification days on the day of the competition at the secretaries box. Or you can send a sae to Tumpy Green within 14 days of the competition. Each qualification card is £12. The competitors must then complete the Qualification Card and send it the Trailblazers Central Office to register their qualification.

### **Dressage Classes:**

Relaxed dress, optional plaiting. Qualification opportunities for those scoring 58% and above.

### **Please Note**

1. The judge's decision is final
2. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fee
3. Correctly fitted footwear and headgear that conform to the current safety standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
5. In the event of cancellation, your entry fee will be carried over to the next Tumpy Green event. No Refunds given.
6. A vet's or doctor's certificate will be required if a withdrawal is made and request for a refund given due to the incapacity of horse or rider
7. No jewellery to be worn and long hair to be secured above collar height.
8. The pure dressage classes will be run under BD rules.
