## COVID 19 – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS SETS OUT THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO WHICH YOU MUST AGREE

Given the current circumstances our Hunter Trial is having to run in a different format so that we comply with Government guidelines to keep people safe and ensure that everyone complies with the Covid 19 conditions.

This will be a **'HAVE A GO' non competitive Hunter Trial.** There will be no judging of fences, timing or unfortunately rosettes. In order to reduce contact between people or objects there will be no facilities on site – no toilets, no refreshments. There will be Paramedics on site.

All entries must be made and paid for in advance with a closing date of **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September** and **no entries will be accepted after this date**. Classes will be strictly limited and if not enough entries are made by the closing date the event will be cancelled.

Only individual classes will be run, no pairs, to ensure social distancing around the site and on the course. You may enter more than one class. Although pairs classes are not running if a family pair wished to go round together then that can be accommodated. Please indicate on your entry sheet if you wish to go round as a family pair. **Every entry will have a time allocation**, therefore limiting the number of riders on site at any one time.

Riders would be expected to ride at their allocated times or risk being unable to take part. Riders would also be expected to maintain social distancing when riding and once they have finished their classes to leave the site as promptly as possible.

Riders are only allowed to have maximum of 4 other people in their group [ie 5 in total including the rider]

Walking the course the day before only, **NO walking the course on the day**. We hope to do a video of a course walk which will be posted on our Facebook page but all entrants will be emailed a course map.

No numbers will be given out. Riders will be registered by a steward at the collecting ring before their start time. Riders must be at the collecting ring 6 minutes before their start time.

There will be an open warm up area monitored by a steward who will be the only person to alter the practice jumps. Riders and any supporters will be expected to socially distance.

All riders and anyone in their group would be expected to ensure their own hygiene arrangements.

Parking-the parking field is extremely large and entrants will be guided to park with 10 metre distances between boxes.
