- The highest place SDRC member in each class will receive a special rosette, posted to them after the event
- Placings and results will be made available on ridingclubresults.co.uk and will be uploaded to the SDRC website and Facebook page. No results will be printed and placed for viewing at the event due to Covid-19.

Class five:	80cm Pairs	Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021	
Class six:	Non-competitive individual chance to jump a mix of 80 or 90cm jumps around the course *		
Class seven:	90cm Individual	Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021	
Class eight:	90 cm Pairs		

\* NOTE – if riders go on from these classes to enter either the 80cm or 90cm classes, they must do so as a non-competitive entry, because they will have experienced the course already. Given the lack of events this year, we have added these classes so riders have an opportunity to try some larger fences around a course.

# **Booking Process:**

- Entries accepted up to 8pm 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020.
- Standard fees apply to midnight on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
- £5 late entry fee applies from 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
- In addition to your entry fee a £5 starting fee per individual competitor (not class) is payable to contribute to the cost of medical cover. To minimise contact at the event and follow Covid-19 guidance, the starting fee is to be paid *in advance* on HorseMonkey and will be refunded if the rider does not compete in any class on the day.
- If the event is cancelled for <u>any</u> reason after the closing date of 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020, your entry fees will be refunded less £10 administration fee, which will contribute towards the costs we will not be able to recoup.

## **COVID-19 Arrangements**

The organisers will implement Covid-19 arrangements for the event, in line with BRC guidance. Details will be posted and sent to all riders nearer to the event, based on the latest guidance available. <u>HOWEVER PLEASE NOTE</u>

- You must all please fill out a track and trace form with your entry and email this to the secretary Katie Kimber on <u>Lloyd-katie@hotmail.co.uk</u> This form will be emailed to you after you have entered on HorseMonkey.
- Only 1 helper per horse is allowed at the event unless the rider is U18
- Tie-up for horses will only be allowed on 1 side of each lorry / trailer
- If any of the Covid-19 guidelines for competitors are not adhered to on the day, competitors will be politely asked to leave the event and will forfeit their entry/start fees.

### **Times and Course walk**

Times will be available on the SDRC Facebook page and website no later than 7pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The course may be walked from 2pm on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

# **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Neither the committee, landowners nor any person acting on their behalf can accept responsibility for any loss, damage, accident or injury to horses, ponies, riders or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 2. Body protectors are compulsory. It is the responsibility of the competitor to wear a BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label must be worn.
- 3. Competitors must wear a protective hat (as per the BRC rules) bearing the CE mark. Hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 <u>and</u> another standard such as those listed:

PAS 015 (1998 or 2011), VG1 01.040 (2014-12), ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) SNELL E2001, AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards)

- 4. No horse or pony may be ridden by more than one competitor in the same class.
- 5. The decision of the organiser is final in all classes.
- No refunds of entry fees will be made for withdrawals after the closing date of Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2020. However your start fee will be refunded.
- 7. A rider will be eliminated and not be allowed to continue on the course following a fall.
- 8. In the event of a fall off the course a rider MUST see the paramedic/vet on site before remounting. If the paramedic / vet feels that the rider or horse/pony is unfit to continue they will ask the competitor to leave the course. The Paramedic / vet's decision is final in this situation.
- 9. The British Riding Club's Third Party insurance does <u>not</u> apply to those who are not members of BRC. All non-riding Club members <u>must</u> have their own insurance arrangements, whether personal or through the Pony Club.
- 10. If the event is cancelled for any reason AFTER the closing date, entry fees will be refunded minus a £10 fee towards the cancellation liabilities.
- 11. Please read and familiarise yourself with the overall British Riding Club Competition rules which will be applied for this competition at <a href="http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook">http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook</a>
- 12. The XC penalties applied are the same as BRC / BE XC phases
- 13. The placings in each class will be determined by those who have zero penalties and are closest to the optimum time for the course to the nearest 100<sup>th</sup> of a second.

- The optimum times and course length will not be published before each class in line with Eland Lodge rules. The speed for each of the competitive classes is as follows: 70cm 420mpm; 80cm 435mpm; 90cm 450mpm
- 15. Any challenges to the placings / results MUST be made within 30 minutes of them being published on ridingclubresults.co.uk to the secretary Katie Kimber on 07870737613
- 16. All Covid-19 guidance for riders and their helpers MUST be followed without exception and anyone that doesn't adhere to them will be asked to leave the site immediately, forfeiting any entry/start fees.
- 17. All riders will be given a start time for their run on the XC course and you will be allowed into the XC collecting ring no earlier than 20 minutes prior to that time, again due to Covid-19 guidelines. If you miss your time slot for any reason, the organisers cannot guarantee being able to slot you in and you risk forfeiting your run / entry / start fee.
- 18. It is expected that all horses will have flu vaccinations within 12 months of the competition date. We have stewards who will be checking passports on a random basis throughout the day. Any horses without a passport, or who's vaccinations are not up to date and within 12 months of the competition date will be politely asked to leave the event and will forfeit their entry/start fees.
- 19. All riders U18 must have a parent or guardian on site at all times who will be responsible for them.

#### Entries:

- Entries are through Horse Monkey only please.
  - When searching for the event in HorseMonkey, our tips are to:
    - Ensure that you have a date range that includes 6<sup>th</sup> September 2020
    - In the organiser filter look for Shrewsbury and District Riding Club
    - DO NOT put the venue as Berriewood it won't show up if you have this in a filter, because it is organised by SDRC and not Berriewood <sup>(3)</sup>
- With these tips in place the Hunter Trials should come up in your search list.
  - 1. Add the start fee (class 1) into your basket for each rider (not class) that you are paying for
  - 2. Add the classes that you wish to enter carefully selecting whether you are an SDRC member or a non-member (we will cross check for any mistakes and contact you)
  - 3. Add anything useful in the notes before you pay (times near to someone you are travelling with for example)
  - 4. Answer the 3 questions at the end
  - 5. Fill out and return the Track and Trace form that will be emailed to you after you have entered on HorseMonkey, to the secretary Katie Kimber <u>Lloyd-katie@hotmail.co.uk</u> for each rider that has entered.
  - 6. Get a cup of tea and relax you are in!!
