SHOW RULES & CONDITIONS

- ❖ Pre-entries only. NO entries will be taken on the day. **Entries close 5th September 2020**
- ❖ Payment must be made by BACS at the time of entry.
- ❖ Entries will be on a first come first served basis, once classes are full, a waiting list will be maintained.
- ❖ All HORSES/PONIES MUST BE UP TO DATE WITH VACCINES. PASSPORTS WILL BE CHECKED.
- ❖ All vehicles must be parked with a minimum of 3 metre distance between each vehicle.
- ❖ All attending the show field are responsible for maintaining social distancing, with at least 2 metres distance between them and others (except those in their own household).
- ❖ Only horses competing are permitted at the show ground.
- ❖ All persons on the show field attend/compete at their own risk, the organisers and land owners are not responsible for any incident that may occur to any horse, rider, dog, handler, spectator, vehicles or property.
- ❖ Dressage classes will be in run in accordance with BD rules.
- ❖ The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or alter the schedule without assigning a reason or without prior notice.
- ❖ **All competitors are expected to be suitably insured for all events.**
- ❖ No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in the show without taking adequate precautions to ensure that members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- ❖ Galloping/cantering in non-competitive areas is strictly forbidden; failure to comply could mean ejection from the show without refund of entries.
- ❖ Hard hats conforming to approved standards must be worn with the chin strap securely fastened at all times when mounted.
- ❖ Foul language and abuse to horses and human alike, will not be tolerated.
- ❖ The correct standard of dress must be worn in all classes i.e. Jacket and jodhpurs. Riding or Jodhpur boots must be worn when mounted.
- ❖ Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of an incident & accompanied by a £20 deposit, which is returned should the objection be sustained.
- ❖ Where age is mentioned, proof of age may be required.
- ❖ All ridden horses must be 4yrs and over.
- ❖ The show organisers strongly recommend that after any fall a visit to the medical centre is made before continuing.
- ❖ Failure to comply with any of the above conditions or the wishes of the show officials may result in ejection from the field without refund of entries.
- ❖ The decision of the organisers on any point not covered above is **FINAL**.

Show Cancellation and Refunds

If the show organisers cancel the show, all entries will be refunded in full. The show can only proceed if it is well supported and therefore, your entry is final and will only be refunded if you are unable to attend due to horse/pony injury, a vets note will be required for any horses unable to compete due to injury.

COVID 19

The show will be operating following government guidance to keep all volunteers, competitors and visitors safe and minimise risk. Failure to comply with any of the conditions or the instructions of the show officials may result in ejection from the field without refund of entries.

- There will be no secretaries' tent. Pre-entries only.
- Closing date 5th September 2020.
- Payment must be made by BACS at the time of entry.
- Entries must include name of competitor and any other individual attending the showground and include up to date contact details (for track & trace purposes).
- You will be required to park at least 3 metres away from other vehicles.
- You will maintain social distancing while on the show ground, keeping a minimum of 2 metres distance from anyone not in your household.
- Classes will be run by times with limited competitors in the ring.
- Times will be available on the Mark Horse Show Facebook page one week prior to the show.
- ***Times in this schedule are approximate only and will be subject to change once entries have been received.***
- You will maintain social distancing while competing and warming up.
- You will only use the designated warm up areas.
- You will be ready to compete at the agreed time. Failure to arrive at the ring at your given time may result in disqualification.
- Passports will be checked upon arrival at the show field and you will be given your competitors number at the gate on arrival.
- Only horses/ponies competing are permitted to attend the show ground.
- Each competitor may bring one helper/spectator to the show with them - per horse or rider, competing.
- While at the showground you should:
 - Maintain hand hygiene (cleaning your hands regularly and appropriately)
 - Maintain respiratory hygiene
 - Avoid touching your face with your hands
 - Follow standard infection prevention and control precautions
- All participants, officials, volunteers and spectators must undergo a self-assessment for any COVID-19 symptoms. No-one should leave home to participate in sport or officiate if they, or someone they live with, has any of the following:
 - A high temperature
 - A new, continuous cough
 - A loss of, or change to, their sense of smell or taste

ENTRY FEES:

Classes 1 to 35 - £8 per class or 3 classes for £20.00.

Classes 36 to 47 - £5 per class or 3 classes for £12.00.
