CONDITIONS

The decision of the Judges on all matters connected with the Gymkhana and Pony Show will be absolutely final, and no appeals will be entertained. Competitors enter entirely at their own risk, and the Committee take no responsibility for mishaps or accidents to any person or persons, vehicles or horses on the field or Show Ground. All riders must wear approved headwear e.g. hard hats at all times and correct footwear when mounted. All dogs on leads. Strictly no galloping or trotting of horses outside designated areas. The Hon. Veterinary Surgeon will be in attendance or on call. Although the time-table will be adhered to as closely as possible, the Committee reserve the right to make any alterations necessary.

If your horse/pony is unwell or has been in contact with any horses/ponies who are unwell please DON'T come to the show. At the show please minimize contact between yourself and your horse/pony and other riders/horses/ponies. Don't share buckets/grooming kit/rugs etc and don't allow your horse/pony to graze at the show ground.
