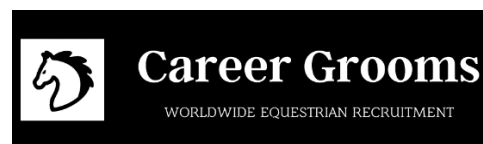

Topscore rules

Each obstacle is clearly marked with a number of points from 10 to 120 according to its difficulty. The time allowed is 60 seconds and starts when the judge rings the bell and the competitor crosses the start line in either direction. The competitor jumps what obstacles he/she chooses and may do so in either direction, each obstacle can be jumped twice, if jumped more than twice no further points would be awarded. Refusals are not penalised. The competitor scores the number of points allotted to each obstacle provided it is jumped clear. No points are awarded for an obstacle knocked down and the obstacle will not be rebuilt. An additional obstacle to be known as the Joker will be built as an upright and can be jumped twice, if jumped

clear 200 points are awarded, if knocked down then 200 points are deducted. The bell is rung when the time allowed is reached, the competitor then must cross the finish line in either direction. If there is equality on points, then the time to cross the finish line will resolve ties.

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Jumping Course, Hickstead from Thursday 16th – Sunday 19th September 2021. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors from Lead Rein to 1.05m

Qualification: 1st – 6th place. (Classes 1 & 2 only Juniors qualify, classes 4 & 8 are NOT qualifiers).
Qualification does not pass down the line. **Juniors must be 16 years & under on 01/01/21.**

Rules

1. To be run under British Riding Club rules 2021.
2. The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
3. Wearing of riding hats and chin straps to the current BSI standard is compulsory when mounted. Suitable footwear to be worn whilst mounted. From January 2016 onwards, BRC will not accept the EN1384 nor BSEN1384 standard for riding hats unless they are combined with a further standard and a kite mark.
4. The Committee and Organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident, loss or damage to competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or property for any reason.
5. The Committee have the right to refuse admission to the showground to any horse or person for any reason.
6. Membership must be fully paid up before benefiting from discounted class prices.
7. Any horse or pony competing in riding events must be 4 years of age or over in the current year and must be of sound condition.
8. Excessive use of the whip and/or spurs in any class will result in elimination.
9. You are expected to ride on your allocated times. If you do not do so, you risk being unable to compete.
10. Dogs are allowed but MUST be always kept on a short lead. No Exceptions. Please ensure you clean up after your dog(s).
11. Litter must not be dropped.
12. Entry fees cannot be returned after the closing date of entries. In the event of cancellation 25% of the entry fee will be retained to cover administration costs.
13. The decision of the judge is final. Arguing with the judge or general abusive behaviour on the showground will invite elimination.
14. Any objection/complaint must be put in writing and handed to the Show Secretary not more than one hour after the class and must be accompanied by £20. If the objection/complaint is found to be justified by the Committee at their next meeting the £20 will be refunded.
15. The Committee reserve the right to alter the programme or to consolidate classes or abandon classes. Also, to amend or add to these rules as they feel necessary.
16. Non-members competing at the show must hold their own up to date 3rd party insurance
17. All equines must have up to date flu vaccinations (booster within 12 months of show date)

COVID RULES

18. Social distancing rules must be followed at all times whilst on the showground. Stay 2m apart from anyone outside your household!
19. Wear gloves or practise hand hygiene after touching field and arena gates.
20. Maximum 7 horses in the warm up arena at any one time.
21. Please do not arrive more than one hour before your class is due to start.
22. Park lorries and trailers at least 3 metres apart.
23. Please do not bring more helpers than necessary.
24. When you have finished your classes please load up and leave promptly to keep numbers on the field to a minimum.
25. Strictly no entry to the office or yard.
26. All entries and payment in advance only via My Riding Life. No entries on the day. Times will be available at www.ffrc.org.uk after 4pm on the Friday prior to the competition.
