#### Class 2 LEAD REIN PONY

Not exceeding 12.2hh. Suitable for and to be ridden by children 8 years and under. Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle. The same rider and pony combinations cannot compete in classes 2 and 3.

#### Class 3 FIRST RIDDEN PONY

Not exceeding 12.2hh. Suitable for and to be ridden by children 10 years and under off the leading rein. No cantering except for individual show (optional). Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle. The same rider and pony combination cannot compete in classes 2 and 3.

#### Class 4 BEST FAMILY HORSE/PONY

Riders will be asked to give a short show including a small jump that may be altered at the discretion of the judge. To be judged on show, manners and suitability for the rider. Confirmation not considered. Horses and ponies any height. Riders any age.

Racehorses to riding horses need not necessarily have raced; however, all horses must have been in training at some time and registered with Wetherbys. To be assessed on conformation, manners and way of going.

- Class 21 VERY NOVICE JUMPING Fences 1'9" max. Unassisted, combinations not to have won an unassisted show jumping competition.

- Class 23 2'3" JUMPING

#### **RULES FOR THE SHOW**

- 1. The Show Committee and Landowner do not accept any responsibility or liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any person, animal or property whatsoever arising out of this show.
- 2. COVID-19, if you are displaying any symptoms, you MUST NOT attend the show. Please keep an eye on our website for updates nearer the time over spectators and numbers of people, who can attend with a competitor, this will be updated dependent on the Government Road Map.
- 3. Horses must only be walking on the showground unless they are in the collecting ring to warm up.
- 4. The decision of the Judges is final
- Objections must be handed to the secretary within 30 minutes of the incident with £100 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
- 6. Refunds will only be given on production of a valid Veterinary or Doctor's certificate 14 days prior to the show. A fee of £4 for admin will be held by the show.
- 7. The Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any class and to refuse any entry.
- 8. First aid cover will be £2 per competitor to assist with the cost of the First Aid Cover.
- 9. Anyone mounted must wear hats complying with standard PAS015:1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI kite marked or Inspec IC marked. VG1 01.040:201412 provided they are BSI kite marked or Inspec IC must be work. It is recommended that everyone (especially 16yrs and under) showing in hand must also wear a hard hat as above with a secure fitting chin strap. Body protectors are recommended.
- 10. Jackets and proper riding boots must be worn in the showing ring.
- 11. Galloping is strictly forbidden.
- 12. No misuse of the whip will be allowed.
- 13. Any outside assistance, bad language to other competitors, judges or officials will incur elimination.
- 14. All dogs must be kept on a lead and cleared up after. Please note Rush Farm is a working farm with livestock around.
- 15. The practice fence must only be jumped in the direction flagged and at the appropriate height for the class.
- 16. Late entries may be accepted on the field if classes are not already full, plus 25% of the original cost of the class.
- 17. Competitors are responsible for having their own insurance in place.
- 18. No stallion to be led or ridden by any person under 16years.
- 19. If you are competing or attending on your own then it is your responsibility to ensure the secretary has a contact detail for your preferred person in case of emergency.
- 20. All horses and ponies must have had a vaccination certificate issued with the last 12 months. This must be available for inspection should it be required.
- 21. Please ensure all rubbish and muck is taken home.
