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- 1. Ages as at 1st January 2021.
- 2. Each competitor to provide their own number bib and clearly print their competitor number.
- 3. Start times will be issued for each rider in each class. These may alter on day depending on how fast classes run.
- 4. This competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2021. The judge's decision will be final.
- 5. Classes will be SINGLE PHASE jumping, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated.
- 6. No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the Team Manager/Person bringing/Person competing to familiarise the competitors with the correct turnout requirements as tack inspection is subject to COVID restrictions.
- 8. Correct protective helmets must be tagged as per Pony Club 2021 rules.
- 9. The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
- 10. The warm up arena will be stewarded and no more than 5 competitors will be allowed in the area at one time, except for class 1.
- 11. The jumps in the warm up arena must not exceed the height of the jumps in the main ring.
- 12. The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion, also to change start times. Please be prepared and allow enough time for classes to run early or late.
- 13. Late changes to entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
- 14. All horses and ponies coming to this event must have a current in date Flu vaccination. Horse/Pony passports must be brought and available for inspection. Please do not bring your pony/horse if it is unwell.
- 15. Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 16. The organiser of the Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 17. Dogs must preferably be left at home. Those that have to be brought to the event must be kept on leads at all times.
- 18. Please respect the venue and clean up after your pony.

#### **COVID-19 Rules**

#### Pony Club COVID-19 protocol.

- 1. Upon arrival you will be checked in & numbers will be strictly limited to one adult per competitor & no additional children or spectators.
- 2. Parking must be a minimum of 5m apart.
- 3. Please follow any one-way systems in place & do not stop to chat or loiter.
- 4. Having finished the event & seen to your horse or pony please load up & head home as soon as possible.
- 5. Social distancing should be adhered to maintaining a 2m distance between competitors at all times Competitors & supporters should wash/sanitise hands regularly.
- 6. Competitors are reminded that the use of face masks can help to reduce the spread of infection & are encouraged to wear them, but this is not mandated.
- 7. On site catering will be available outside for take-away foods only. Social distancing must be maintained throughout the purchasing & consumption of any food & drink.
