PRE ENTRIES ONLY – ENTRIES CLOSE TUESDAY 29TH JUNE

Classes start at 9:00am promptly - all Single Phase

Classes 1-5 are qualifiers for the 2021 Pony Club Mini Championships – at Bicton Arena on Thursday 26th August 2021 - but open to all (only Pony Club teams are eligible for qualification).

Class 6 is a qualifier for the 70cm 2021 Showjumping Championships – at Bicton Arena on Wednesday 25th August 2021 - but open to all (only Pony Club teams are eligible for qualification).

OUTDOOR ARENA

SASHES TO WINNING TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL, ROSETTES TO 6TH AND ALL UNPLACED DOUBLE CLEARS

Class 1 Teams and Individuals LEAD REIN - 40cm - Rosettes to all (rider must be 10 years and under to qualify)

Class 2 Teams and Individuals ASSISTED - 40cm — Rosettes to all (rider must be 12 years and under to qualify)

Class 3 Teams and Individuals NO ASSISTANCE - 40cm

GRASS ARENA

SASHES TO WINNING TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL, ROSETTES TO 6TH – ALL CLASSES

Class 4 Teams and Individuals - 50cm

Class 5 Teams and Individuals - 60cm

Class 6 Teams and Individuals - 70cm

Class 7 Teams and Individuals - 80cm

If anyone would like to be in a team but can't raise a whole team mark your entry form accordingly and we will try to help.

Rules

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions and it is a condition of entry that these have been accepted by each competitor.

All classes will be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2020. You can view the rules at www.pcuk.org.

The organisers have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of every one present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the Landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents or accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

The Judge's decision is final and any objections must be accompanied by £25 deposit which will be returned if upheld. Horse/Pony must be 4 years or over on day of show. All dogs must be kept on lead.

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without stating a reason and also to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places themselves or others in danger or fails to observe the rules.

Combinations may only jump in one ring not both.

Times will be given for each competitor and must be strictly adhered to. These will be posted on the South Devon Pony Club Open Facebook page and website on Thursday 1st July.

In the event that the competition has to be cancelled all entries will be refunded minus a £5 admin fee.

General Guidelines for Team Show Jumping

- Declarations from 8.15am
- Tack and Hat check at warm up arenas
- Teams will be of three or four riders best three scores will count.
- LEAD REIN RIDERS must remain on the lead rein at all times whilst in the ring including entering and leaving the ring and whilst warming up.
 Any breach will incur a 10 point penalty.
- ASSISTED TEAMS One adult is allowed to assist in the ring whilst the competitor jumps his/her round. PLEASE NOTE - No contact to be made with rider or pony whilst in the ring including entering and leaving the ring.
 Any breach will incur a 10 point penalty.

- One competitor may ride no more than two horses/ponies in the same team each horse/pony may only compete once
- All competitors to report to collecting ring 20 minutes before they are due to jump for tack inspection
- Riders may qualify for two levels but the combination can't compete at the champs at the 40cm and 60cm it has got to be the 40cm and 50cm or the 50cm and 60cm.
- Top 2 Pony Club teams and top 3 Pony Club Individuals qualify for the Regional Pony Club Mini Championships at Bicton in each section

Covid 19 Rules

- Social distancing is to be practised at all times. The latest COVID guidance from Pony Club is available here https://pcuk.org/coronavirus-advice/
- Strictly only one additional supporter to come with each combination if you are unable to adhere to this rule for logistical reasons please do not enter.
- Lead rein combinations will be counted as two people in the warm up area.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser and face mask for emergency use.
- Maximum numbers in the warm up area should not exceed four riders at any one time
 with one additional team helper. Each competitor is responsible for ensuring their tack is
 safe.
- No spectators or parents in the warm up area. The warm up arena will be stewarded and only a maximum of five competitors may be in the warm up at the same time. The steward may limit numbers further at their disgression.
- The practice fences will be manned by a steward and under no circumstances may anybody else touch them including lead rein leaders.
- Jumps in the warm up arena may not exceed the height of the jumps in the ring.
- Riders should maintain a suitable horse distance apart from other competitors at all times.
