Ring 3 - MINI JUMPING RING - classes commence at 12.00 noon

Clear Round Jumping will commence at 10.00 until 12.00 £3 per round or 2 for £5 Competitors who compete in Ring 1 are not eligible to compete in this ring. Enter on the day, please bring change to minimise contact.

- 20. Novice Mini Jumping, Combination not to have been placed 1st (individually) in any show jumping competition. (May be Led) Approx 30 cm, Sash to winner, rosettes to all, prizes and Best Tiverton Member.
- 21. Lead Rein Jumping, approx. 30 cm. Lead Rein Only Sash to winner, rosettes to all, prizes and Best Tiverton Member
- 22. Open mini jumping, 30 cm may be led Sash to winner, rosettes, prizes and Best Tiverton Member
- Open Mini Jumping Approx 40 cm. no lead rein but may be assisted winner, rosettes, prizes and Best Tiverton Member
- 24. Open Mini Jumping approx. 50 cm no lead rein but may be assisted Sash to winner, rosettes, prizes and Best Tiverton Member

At the end of each class the rosettes/sashes will be made available for collection

The show committee reserves the right to modify the schedule/classes as necessary and may refuse entry.

Classes may clash and it is the competitors' responsibility to inform the ring steward if they withdraw from a class or will be late.

The Judges' decision is final. Any objection should be made in writing to the Secretary on the day within an hour of the class concerned with a £10 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

No Galloping outside the rings.

All competitors take part at their own risk and should be mindful of their own and others' safety at all times.

The practice jump will be flagged (red flag on right) and an adult must be in attendance when in use.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

All persons mounted must wear a protective riding helmet which conforms to current safety standards such as PAS015; 1998 or EN1384 1996.

Horses and ponies ridden must be at least 4 years of age.
