CLASS ENTRY FEES

Horse Show classes are £4 in advance, or £5 on the day. All entries must be made with the Secretary and paid for before the start of each class.

Please complete an Entry Form and email or post to the Secretary. Entries close: Wed 4th August – entry & payment to be received by Midnight. The exceptions are; Clear Round jumping & Dog Show entries – these are payable at the ringside.

£1 MEDICAL CHARGE There will be a charge of £1 per horse, which will go towards the cost of providing medical cover. This is payable at the time of booking entries.

EMERGENCIES

- Emergency Services must have access to all parts of the show field at all times – no vehicles should be parked so as to obstruct access.
- In case of an emergency, members of the public should contact the secretary or nearest official who will contact the Medical Officer or Emergency Services as necessary.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY– The Organiser of the show has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone on the show field. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all the officials. Please adhere to the Welsh COVID-19 restrictions as they stand on the day.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY - No liability can be accepted by the Organiser for any loss, damage, injury, accident or illness to horses, riders, dogs, handlers, owners, spectators, vehicles, their contents and accessories, or to any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. Competitors are advised to have their own Public Liability insurance.

GENERAL CARE

- Entry to show field only, not to neighbouring land or tracks.
- Horses can be easily frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to remain in the spectator areas only, keeping clear of horse arenas/lanes, and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses or dogs ie, sudden movements or loud noises.
- **All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times** and those riding must be supervised by an adult experienced with horses. Dogs must be kept under control at all times and must be kept on leads except when permitted to do so by the Dog Show Judge or Steward.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE – SHOW RULES:

- Horses with an infectious disease or known to have been in contact with such must not attend the show field.
- No entries will be accepted without payment of fees and extra £1 medical charge per horse – see page 2
- Classes with 3 entries or less may receive 1st place rosette only.
- First prize winners are NOT eligible to compete in Local classes.
- Local Classes – owners to reside within a 7 mile radius of the Anchor.
- Young Handlers – 16 years and under, must be competent. Any ponies out of control will be asked to leave the ring.
- Children entered in the ‘Leading Rein’ Class 12 may enter other classes but must be on a Lead rein.
- Horses must be under the supervision of an experienced, responsible adult and under control at all times. No person may handle or ride another person’s horse without permission.
- Mountain and Moorland to be shown in their natural state.
- **Horses are to be kept in Competitor areas only** – they must not be taken into public areas including the Entries Trailer.
- No galloping around the show field.
- Horses known to kick must wear a red band on their tail.
- Stallions must be bitted and handled by an adult.
- Appropriate headgear and suitable footwear must be worn at all times whilst riding.
- Correct Competitor Numbers must be worn and be visible whilst competing.
- Any persons reported for abusing a horse or using foul language will be ejected from the show field.
- Horses should not be left unattended whilst tethered.
- The Judge’s decision is final and may split classes at his discretion.
- The decision of the Committee will be final in matters of dispute, and they reserve the right to amend, amalgamate or cancel any class and to refuse any entry at their own discretion.
- Objections must be made in writing to the show secretary within 30 minutes of the incident and a deposit of £5 lodged, which will be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
- Agreement with the above rules is deemed a condition of entry.

Entry Fee per class: £4 in advance

1. **Best Turned Out Horse/Pony & Handler**
2. **Welsh Mountain, Sections A, B, C & D** any age, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, registered or unregistered (if sufficient entries class may be split between A&Bs, C&Ds or at judge's discretion)
3. **Open Cob** - any age/height
4. **Open Youngstock – Best 1, 2 or 3yr old** – any breed
5. **Young Handler** – 16yrs & under. Competent handlers only please
6. **Family Horse/Pony** – must be suitable for handler. Any breed/age
7. **Coloured Horse/Pony**, any age (inc Roan/Spot/Dun/Palamino)
(if sufficient entries class may be split between horses and ponies or at judge's discretion)
8. **Mountain & Moorland** (incl Shetland, excl Welsh) any age or height, registered or unregistered (if sufficient entries class may be split)
9. **Foreign Breed** (incl part bred and Arabs)
10. **Veteran Horse/Pony** (15yrs & over) can be in-hand or ridden

- 11. Best Turned Out Horse/Pony & Rider** (excl Welsh)
- 12. Best Turned Out Welsh Mountain Horse/Pony & Rider**
(if sufficient entries class may be split A&Bs, C&Ds)
- 13. Best Lead Rein Horse/Pony**
(Riders in this class may only compete in other classes if on a lead rein)
- 14. Mountain & Moorland Horse/Pony**, registered or unregistered
(if sufficient entries class may be split or at judge's discretion)
- 15. Pony Club Pony** - suitable for PC activities, 14.2hh & under – rider to be of suitable size for pony
- 16. Riding Club Horse** – suitable for RC activities, over 14.2hh – rider to be of suitable size for horse
- 17. Best Trekking Horse/Pony** (any type)
- 18. Best Horse** - over 14.2hh (incl Riding Horse, Hunter & RoR)
- 19. Fancy Dress** – can be led, ridden or driven

GUNDOG SCURRY: Steeplechase £2 per run Rosettes to 5th place

Steeplechase – the dog retrieves a dummy thrown at the end of a row of jumps in the quickest time possible. One placing per person – only your quickest run will score!

Always great excitement, as runners try to beat their previous time!

£5 on the day

**RULES – All show-jumping classes will be judged as per BS rules, with the exception that elimination of a competitor will be on 3 refusals (not 2).*

Please note: A fall of horse or rider will result in elimination
