SCHEDULE

Showing Starting at 9am

- Class 1: Novice Ridden Showing any height, open to combinations with no more than 3 wins.
- Class 2: Riding Horse or Pony/Hunter—any height may be split if sufficient numbers.
- Class 3: Veteran Horse or Pony 15 years or over may be split depending on numbers. VHS Qualifier
- Class 4: Cob open to all types of cob

Judge's break

Class 5: Coloured Horse or Pony Traditional or non-traditional, may be split depending on numbers Traditional coloured horses and ponies must have feather and full mane and tail.

Non-Traditional: Plaited or hogged with no feather.

Class 6: M & M May split into large and small breeds, depending on numbers.

Small Breeds: Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh Section A & B.

Large Breeds: Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D.

Part breeds not permitted.

Class 7: Thoroughbred – Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses

Best in Show – For all combinations placed 1^{st} in classes 1-7

In Hand Showing Classes

Class 9. 3 Years & Under Young Stock - Open to fillies, colts and geldings aged 3yrs & under

Class 10. Best Conditioned

Class 11. In-hand Cob - Open to cob horses and ponies

Class 12. M&M May split into large and small breeds, depending on numbers.

Small Breeds: Exmoors, Shetlands, Dartmoors, Welsh Section A & B. Part breeds not permitted Large Breeds: Connemara, Dales, Highland, Fells, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D. Part breeds not permitted.

Class 13. Veteran Horse & Pony 15yrs or Over - Open to any horse and pony 15yrs or over.

Veteran Horse Society qualifier.

Judge's break

Class 14. Coloured Horse or Pony Traditional or non-traditional, may be split depending on numbers Traditional coloured horses and ponies must have feather and full mane and tail. Non-Traditional: Plaited or hogged with no feather.

Class 15. Best Foreign Breed - Open to any type of pure-bred foreign breed of hose and ponies

Class 16: Thoroughbred – Open to horses bred to race, trained, have raced or retired racehorses

Best in Show (Champions and Reserve Champion) – For all horses / ponies who have won an in-hand class today class.

CLASS 17: Mini Show Jumping (cross poles, may be assisted, including lead rein)

CLASS 18: Show Jumping 40cm (may be assisted)

CLASS 19: Show Jumping 50cm Area 9 SJ Championships Qualifier

CLASS 20: Show Jumping 60cm Area 9 SJ Championships Qualifier, Hartpury Qualifier

CLASS 21: Show Jumping 70cm Area 9 SJ Championships, Trailblazers Direct, Hartpury Qualifier

CLASS 22: Show Jumping 80cm Area 9 SJ Championships, Trailblazers Direct, Hartpury Qualifier

CLASS 23: Show Jumping 90cm Area 9 SJ Championships, Trailblazers Direct, Hartpury Qualifier

CLASS 24: Show Jumping 100cm Area 9 SJ Championships, Trailblazers Direct, Hartpury Qualifier

Class heights: the class height is the maximum height of fences in the first section; fences in the jump-off section may be increased by up to 5cm over the class height.

Working Hunter Approx. 2pm Start

All Working Hunter classes are open to both horses and ponies, children and adults. Ideal if you want to give it a go!

Class 25: Introductory Working Hunter. Max 50cm.

Class 26: Novice Working Hunter. Max 60cm

Class 27: Intermediate Working Hunter. Max 70cm

Class 28: Open Working Hunter. Max 80cm

Best in Show Working Hunter (Champions and Reserve Champion) – For all horses / ponies who have won a class 25-28.

ENTRY FEES:

Showing classes £10 per combination per class.

Show Jumping classes: £13 per combination per class.

Working Hunter classes: £15 per combination per class.

Late entries will be subject to a £5 per class additional fee.

£3 First Aid per combination (one pony/one rider)

Rosettes: to sixth place in each class.

CLOSING DATE: The Thursday before the competition. Entries are available on the day if classes are not full in advance and are subject to the late entry fee. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held. Start Time: Class 1, will not start before 9.00am

TIMES: start lists with times will be in the documents section of Equo Events, and Tumpy Green Equestrian Centre's Facebook page; by the evening of Friday before the competition.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 1st - 3rd October 2021. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule.

- 2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- 3. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third-party cover. The Tumpy Green Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover them.

RULES AND NOTICES

- 1. Substitutions allowed please tell the Secretary (Entries before the day, Show on the day).
- 2. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date, please ring/email the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.
- 3. Closing date for entries Thursday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.)
- 4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be help in credit for a future event. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
- 5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN please see the documents section of Equo Events. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time please be ready.
- 6. Warm-up Arena the number of competitors may be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use the warm-up.
- 7. Children must not jump in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
- 8. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each and in a maximum of three classes. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary via the Rider's DC and must wear stallion discs and ribbons. All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.
- 9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses in SJ classes should be as in the Pony Club / Riding Club Rules for Show-jumping 2021. For showing classes, please dress according to the class type. Please see Veteran Horse Society website for rules and guidance regarding their qualifiers.
- 10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.

- 11. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
- 12. INSURANCE; please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
- 13. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena, before you jump.
- 14. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Tumpy Green Competition Centre will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
- 15. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road. All hay must be collected and removed from the lorry park.
- 16. Show-Jumping classes will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2021. Showing will be run according to the type of class. Please see Veteran Horse Society website for rules and guidance regarding their qualifier.
