SHOW RULES

- 1. The Judge's decision is final. Any complaints regarding the judge's decision will not be accepted.
- 2. All ages for both horse & rider are taken from the 1st of January in the current year. All riders/handlers must have attained their 3rd birthday on the date of the show. All ridden horse/ponies must be at least 4yrs old to compete in any ridden class.
- 3. The centre reserves the right to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes if sufficient/insufficient entries.
- 4. Hard Hats to current BSI standards with a chin strap to be worn in all ridden classes and inhand classes by handlers 16 years and under.
- 5. No refund of entries will be allowed under any circumstances.
- 6. The organisers accept no responsibility or liability for any loss, incident or accident(s) to persons, equines or property.
- 7. All competitors must hold a minimum of third-party liability insurance.
- 8. No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground.
- 9. The Centre reserves the right to ask anyone demonstrating cruelty or anti-social behaviour to leave the showground and will be banned from any future events.
- 10. If you are not present when your class is due to start, then you will not be allowed into the ring once the class has started. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that they do not miss their class. There will be no refunds if any class is missed.
- 11. Novice classes Please enter this class in the spirit that it is intended.
- 12. No spurs are allowed to be worn by any competitor under the age of 16yrs in any class. Any competitor over the age of 16yrs may wear spurs if riding a horse exceeding 148cms and if the class allows it.
- 13. No form of bullying, harassment or nasty comments, whether in person or on social media will not be tolerated and any person found to be doing so will be banned from all events and removed from the showground immediately.
- 14. Foals must be at least 30 days old on the show day.
- 15. NO POINTS shall be accumulated from the youngstock classes.
- 16. No horse/pony to be left tied to a trailer/lorry unattended.
- 17. All stallions and colts 2 years+ must be bitted. Age of handlers for stallions or colts, or riders of stallions as follows: Stallions/Colts not exceeding 13.2hh- minimum age of handler/rider 12yrs. Stallions/Colts 13.2hh and over minimum age of handler/rider 14yrs.
- 18. Lead rein handlers must be at least 16 years of age.
- 19. Take all rubbish & waste home.
- 20. When attending the show, please respect our liveries by remaining off the yards and no wandering around the premises.
- 21. Whips: Maximum length of 75cm (30") in all classes.
- 22. SJ and WH heights are at Judge's discretion.
- 23. Lead rein ponies to be shown in snaffle bridle and lead rein to be attached to the noseband.
- 24. Lead rein competitors to be 9 years and under (age at 1st January 2021)
- 25. First Ridden competitors to be 12 years and under (age at 1st January 2021)
- 26. All mounted/in hand horses and ponies must be shown in appropriate tack.
- 27. All competitors to wear correct and appropriate show attire for the classes they wish to enter.
- 28. If a rider or horse is involved in a fall then this should be reported to the show secretary on the day.
- 29. All earrings and body studs to be removed before entering any ring as a competitor.
- 30. Regardless of age, the rider must be a suitable height/weight for the horse/pony, including lead rein. If the judge deems a horse and rider combination inappropriate; they will be dismissed from the class. No refunds will be made. The judge's decision is final.
- 31. The winner of the Novice Showing Class at the end of year presentation will no longer be eligible to enter and will be de-noviced.
- 32. Parking is available on the showground at your own risk. The Committee accept no responsibility for damage to vehicles or its contents
- 33. The Committee reserves the right to omit classes from future shows if insufficient entries.

- 34. Objections- £50.00 to be deposited to a committee member within 30 minutes of the incident. Written confirmation produced within 7 days, £50.00 will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 35. If these rules cannot be adhered to then competitors will be asked to leave the showground with no refund of entries.
- 36. No rider may ride more than one pony/horse in a class.
- 37. There may be no change of rider from phase one to phase two.

Jumping Rules to apply:

- a) Riders are allowed to walk the course dismounted before their class.
- b) Ponies/horses are not allowed to practice over any part of the course before the commencement of any of the classes.
- c) No person, other than the Judge or the Course Builder appointed by the Show, is permitted to alter the course.
- d) If a combination or double fence is numbered as one fence, penalties incurred at each element are cumulative.
- e) Any pony/horse taking the wrong course or jumping another fence after completing the course will be eliminated.
- f) If a pony/horse positively stops, or turns its quarters to a fence, or has a complete turnaround these constitute refusals. If a pony/horse jumps the incorrect fence out of a pen or lane it will be eliminated. Ponies/horses displaying continued disobedience, or ponies/horses leaving the ring whether mounted or dismounted will be eliminated.
- g) No penalty is incurred unless the max. height of the fence is lowered in the same vertical plane.

(FALL OFF = ELIMINATION) (STEP BACK = REFUSAL) (2 STOPS = ELIMINATION SJ)

(3 STOPS = ELIMINATION WH)

Dress/Tack Code to apply:

- a) There is no requirement for a change of tack for horses/ponies during the Working Hunter classes although bridles should be plain with no colour.
- b) No bandages or schooling aids to be worn on the horse.
- c) Boots of a plain colour may be used for Phase I of the W.H.P./W.H. Classes, but they must be removed before the conformation section.
- d) A body protector can be worn if necessary.
- f) Hard hats to current BSA standards with chin strap must be worn.

Entry Rules to apply:

- a) Entry fees are due at the time of booking.
- b) Entry fees are non-refundable.
- c) All times are approximate and subject to alteration.
- d) Competitors must declare at the working hunter ring.

CHAPS(UK) "This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 21025 Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. This Show is a Qualifier for the 2021 CHAPS (UK) Championship Show – date to be advised PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR 2021 QUALIFIER CARD WITH YOU. APPLICATIONS FOR THIS AVAIALBLE FROM EARLY AUGUST. Ring 1 (Indoor) - 8:30am start

Youngstock (No Points)

- 1. Foals
- 2. Yearlings
- 3. 2 & 3 year olds

Youngstock Championship

All 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 to 3 are eligible to compete.

Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

- 4. Inhand Cob Any age. Traditional, hogged, native.
- 5. Inhand Hunter & Irish Draft Any age. Part & pure bred ID. Must be plaited.
- 6. Inhand Horse Any age & type. Exceeding 14.2hh at maturity.
- 7. Inhand ROR Must be shown plaited.
- 8. Inhand Veteran Horse/pony 15 years old and over. Any height, any type.
- 9. Inhand Coloured Non-Native Type To be shown plaited. Any age, any height. Unusual coloureds welcome.
- 10. Inhand Coloured Native Type To be shown in their natural state. Any age, any height. Unusual coloureds welcome.

In-hand Championship 1.

All 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 4 to 10 are eligible to compete.

Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

- 11. Inhand pony Any age & type. Not exceeding 14.2hh at maturity.
- 12. Inhand part bred Any age, any height. Must be shown plaited except for traditional & native types.
- 13. Inhand M&M Will be judged separately (Small & Large breeds). Any age, any height. Must be shown in their natural state.
- 14. Inhand Novice Horse or Pony Any height, any type, any age. Horses / ponies must be in their first season of inhand showing.
- 15. Inhand New Combination Any height, any age, any type. Combination must be competing in their first full season together.

In-hand Championship 2.

All 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 11 to 15 are eligible to compete.

Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

Ridden

Ring 1 (Indoor) - Not before 12:30pm

Novice Ridden

- 16. Ridden Pre-Novice walk & trot ponies 4 years old and over. Ponies not to exceed 148cms. Snaffle bridles only. Walk & trot on go-round only. Canter in show optional.
- 17. Ridden Pre-Novice walk & trot horses 4 years old and over. Horses exceeding 148cms. Snaffle bridles only. Walk & trot on go-round only. Canter in show optional.
- 18. Ridden Novice 4, 5 & 6 year olds open to any horse or pony aged 4, 5 or 6 years old.
- 19. Ridden Novice rider open to any pony or horse 4 years old and over. Nervous/novice riders only.
- 20. Ridden most promising new combination 4 years old and over. Any type, any height. Horses & ponies. To be in their first full show season together.

Novice ridden Championship.

All 1^{st} & 2nd prize winners from classes 16 to 20 are eligible to compete. Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

Mini Section

- 21.Lead-rein 4 years old and over. Lead-rein riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st Jan 2021. Mares & geldings.
- 22. First ridden 4 years old and over. First ridden riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st Jan 2021. Mares & geldings.
- 23. Tiny Tots Lead-rein & First Ridden Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday. Mares & geldings. Will be split for placings if sufficient entries.
- 24. Young Handler under 12 years Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. Mares & geldings. Will be split for placings if sufficient entries. (8 years and under & 9-12 years).
- 25. Mini Equitation Lead rein welcome. To be judged on performance only. Ponies not to exceed 14.2hh. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday. Mares & Geldings.

Mini Championship

All 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 21 to 25 are eligible to compete.

Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

Open Ridden

- 26.Ridden M&M Will be judged separately (Small & Large breeds). 4 years old and over, any height. Must be shown in their natural state.
- 27. Junior rider 4 years old and over. All riders 18 years and under. Ponies 15hh and under. Any breed, any type.
- 28. Open pony not exceeding 14.2hh. ponies 4 years old and over.
- 29. Ridden cob- including Traditional, Hogged, Native. 4 years old and over.
- 30. Ridden native coloured Traditional, native, hogged, vanner. 4 years old and over.
- 31.Ridden non-native coloured must be shown plaited. 4 years old and over.
- 32. Ridden veteran 15 years and over.
- 33. Ridden hunter pony/horse/Irish Draft 4 years old and over. Part/pure bred ID welcome.
- 34. Ridden ROR 4 years old and over.
- 35. Ridden part-bred any height. Horses and ponies 4 years old and over.
- 36. Open horse exceeding 14.2hh. horses 4 years old and over.

Open Ridden Championship

All 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 26 to 36 are eligible to compete.

Champion & reserve to compete in the overall supreme of show at the end of the day.

Working Hunter

Please note- The class height is the maximum height of the fences. 30cm & 40cm classes will not contain fillers underneath the fences. Please specify if you are competing on a horse or pony on your entry form as these classes will be placed separately.
