Brent Pelham Hunter Trial Rules

Penalties

• 1st refusal - 20 penalties 2nd refusal - 40 penalties



- PP
- 3rd refusal Elimination Jumping an "L" fence 15 penalties
- Stepping back in front of an obstacle will be classed as a refusal.
- A horse crossing its own tracks between parts of a combination fence (e.g. A and B) will be scored as having refused

A horse which knocks a flag or a post over will not be penalised if the horse's shoulders pass the correct side of the flag.

Fall of Horse or Rider and Elimination

- Any fall of horse on any part of the course, (or horse trapped on an obstacle), will incur elimination. The competitor must leave the course immediately.
- An unseated rider incurs **65** penalties. The rider may remount and continue if the Judge is satisfied that he or she is fit to do so. If the Judge believes that the rider is not sufficiently fit, **he or she will be eliminated and must leave the course immediately**.
- In the event of a fall of horse or unseated rider, the Fence Judge will complete an accident form.
- At the Judge's discretion, competitors who are eliminated may continue around the course, providing that they give way and do not obstruct any other competitor. However the Fence Judges have the authority to request that the competitor leaves the course at any time. MISUSE OF THE WHIP or DANGEROUS RIDING are examples for which such a request may be made.

Pairs

Competitors will be judged on their ability to jump side by side over fences which have been marked as "Dressing Fences" on the Course Plan. Penalties will range from zero for a perfectly synchronised jump, to 5 penalties when the two competitors are several horse lengths apart. The scoring for the dressing of fences will be prioritised over the pairs' overall time taken around the course.

Optimum Time

The course will be measured and an optimum time set according to weather and ground conditions on the day.

Outside Assistance

- On the Main Course incurs elimination, except when the rider is dismounted.
- On the Mini Hunter Trial Course some outside assistance, approved by the judge, is permitted in all Clear Round Classes.
- In all other Mini Hunter Trial Classes lead rein competitors will be deducted 20 penalties. Up to 20 penalties may be deducted for any other assistance.

Objections

• Queries regarding class results must be made within 15 minutes from the time they are posted.

Conditions of entry

- I. The Judge's decision is final.
- 2. No horse or pony may be ridden more than once in a class. (Mini Hunter trial classes exempt)
- 3. The event is organised by and on behalf of The Puckeridge Hunt. Neither The Puckeridge Hunt nor any person acting on their behalf accept liability whatsoever for any loss, damage, accident, illness affecting any person, animal or property, whether caused by negligence, Breach of Contract, Breach of Trust or in any other way whatsoever.
- 4. It should be considered a condition of entry that each competitor and spectator shall indemnify the organisers or any person acting on their behalf against legal action arising from accident or incident.
- 5. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instruction of the organisers, officials and stewards.
- 6. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

The Organizers are making The Cross Country Course available for schooling on the strict understanding that riders use the course entirely at their own risk. The Organizers cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury caused to riders, their assistants, horses or property and will allow riders access to the course on this basis only. All riders must sign the Declaration below confirming that they alone carry the responsibility for any accidental injury or damage which may occur as a result of their own or other riders use of the course.

In addition:

- Riders must follow all Stewards' instructions and only jump flagged fences in the correct direction. (e.g. Fence may only be jumped when the RED flag can be seen to be displayed on the RIGHT).
- Current standard Crash Hats, (with a flexible peak), Back Protector and Footwear MUST be worn and correctly fastened when mounted.
- The Start Fee of £20.00, accompanied by this form can be paid on the day at the gate.
- Riders may school for any period of time whilst the course is open. They will need to show consideration for other riders at all times.
- Riders will be required to pay for any damage resulting from their failure to abide by the above conditions.
- All riders under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. It is recommended that adult riders are accompanied by an assistant capable of transporting a horse home in the unfortunate event of an accident.
