FROM M3: EXIT 6 - BASINGSTOKE

- 1. Take the A33 and stay on the Dual Carriageway headed for Newbury.
- 2. Take third exit signposted to Hospital A&E.
- 3. At roundabout take fourth exit signposted A340 towards Aldermaston/Tadley. (Hotel on your right).
- 4. Stay on this road, past hospital on your left.
- 5. Through Sherbourne St. John. Through Pamber End.
- 6. Through Tadley over mini roundabout, up hill, Sainsburys on right, through main traffic lights to rectangular shaped roundabout at top of road (traffic lights at each junction).
- 7. Take second exit at Falcon roundabout to the right Soke Road / Burghfield / Reading. Past Shell Petrol Station on your left. Straight over roundabout and past AWE main gate on your left. Left at next roundabout towards Reading and Burghfield Common.
- 8. Through Padworth Common. Just past sharp right-hand bend in road turn left into The Croft at reflective signs.
- 9. Come through electric wooden gates and follow signs to the stables.
- 10. Note: If you pass the Tadley Fishing Shop on your right you have gone too far!

FROM M4: EXIT 12- THEALE/READING

- 1. Take the A4 towards Newbury/Theale.
- 2. First roundabout straight on. Second roundabout straight on towards Newbury (A4). Past The Spring Inn restaurant on your left.
- Continue for just over a mile and as you pass the petrol station on your left and just before the large sign and roundabout for turn to Aldermaston/Basingstoke), turn left into Padworth Lane on the corner of the Holiday Inn Hotel complex.
- 4. Narrow country road not suitable for HGV take care!
- 5. Stay on this road, do not turn off! Follow road over railway bridge, canal bridge, river bridge and up the hill. Over small crossroad. Becomes single file lane here.
- 6. Continue to end, "T" junction turn left. Continue approx 200 yards, turn left into "The Croft" at reflective signs.
- 7. Come through electric wooden gates and follow signs to the Stables.
- 8. Note: If you pass the Tadley Fishing Shop on your right you have gone too far!

NOTE: If using SAT NAV, you must input: Mays Lane, RG7 4QP Postcode alone will not get you here!!

TERMS AND CONDITIONS - RULES

- 1. The decision of the Judges, Secretary and Stewards is final. The Show is run under British Dressage Rules.
- 2. PLEASE ENSURE YOU BRING YOUR HORSE'S PASSPORT WITH YOU FOR CHECKING. The Croft EC only need yearly vaccinations for Unaffiliated Shows.
- 3. Once a competitors entry has been accepted it will be assumed that they intend to take part unless they notify the promoters to the contrary before the closing date. A full refund (not including the booking fee) less an admin fee totalling the PayPal fee charged for the booking (PayPal fee is 2.9% of total paid, plus 30p per transaction) will be issued if before the closing date.
- 4. No entry fee will be refunded on withdrawal after the closing date.
- 5. The promoters reserve the right to cancel, split or re-arrange any class, and/or the event at their discretion. Entry fees may be refunded less a £1.00 administration fee and the booking fee.
- Correct riding attire must be worn by all Riders. In particular, everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear an approved riding hat as per British Dressage Rules: www.britishdressage.co.uk/rules. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
- 7. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, their property, servants, or horses in connection with, or arising out of this event. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- 8. The promoters reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason whatsoever.
- 9. An objection to the result of any class may only be made by an owner, his authorised agent or rider of a horse competing in the event. Any such person must make his objection in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of that objection and pay a £10 deposit, returnable within 7 days if the objections upheld.
- 10. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
- 11. Horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- 12. Lunging is not permitted in any of the arenas at any time.
- 13. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- 14. The promoters reserve the right to ask any competitor or visitor in breach of these terms and conditions, to leave the grounds immediately.
- 15. The promoters reserve the right to amend these terms and conditions should the need arise.
- 16. Smoking is not permitted whilst mounted, or in either the outdoor or indoor arenas, or inside any buildings.
- 17. The promoters will be taking photographs and videos during our events and these may be posted on the website and Facebook pages of TDRC and/or The Croft EC and used for marketing purposes.
