

RULES AND CONDITIONS

• All horses and ponies **MUST** have at least a Yearly Booster jab, or 2nd lot of Jabs if they have never been vaccinated before/ had to start a new course of vaccinations. You may be asked to present a passport/ proof of vaccinations from a vet.

• Please act responsibly; if your horse is showing signs of equine flu, strangles or any other illness or contagion, or you are showing signs of/ have been in contact with anyone who has Covid-19, please do not attend, for the safety of everyone.

• Due to Health & Safety regulations, NO horses or ponies are to be tied up to the sides of lorries or trailers & left unattended at any time.

• The Organisers accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or property; it shall be condition of entry that competitors will hold organisers blameless & indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings.

• **Hard hats to current safety standards are to be worn & fastened at all times whilst mounted. It is advised that body protectors are worn for jumping classes.**

• No horses under the age of 4 to be ridden on the show ground, no children under the age of 2 to compete, no horses under 1 year old to attend. Stallions/colts must be adequately under control & not exhibited by anyone under the age of 16.

• No cantering nor lunging around the horse boxes/ trailers. All other warmup must be done in consideration to other competitors, spectators & officials. Warm up is also done at your own risk. Any injury to horse or rider is to be accepted as your own responsibility, not the fault of the Organisers.

• We do our best to maintain the ground at a high standard, weather permitting, however please remain cautious & ride sensibly. It is part of our yard turnout, so we cannot always cut the grass extremely short, or keep it perfectly flat.

• No mucking out of horseboxes or trailers on the showground.

• All rubbish is to be put in the bins provided, or your own vehicles, not left on the showground.

• Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times & any fouling to be cleaned up. No aggressive or uncontrollable dogs allowed.

• Standard tack only, no severe spurs, bits or aids allowed.

• **The judges' decisions are final. Please do not abuse any of our judges in any way.**

• The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter any classes, the event, or refuse entries. No refunds given unless classes are cancelled. Afternoon classes not starting exactly on time is not a reason for refund- start times are only approximate & tell you afternoon classes will not start BEFORE, not AT specific times.

• Any complaints must be made in writing & accompanied by £15 deposit within 15 minutes of the end of the class, refundable if the complaint is upheld.

• Competitors and spectators are responsible for their own health & safety, in the event of an accident, an ambulance will be called. If anyone sustains a head injury, they will not be permitted to get back on any horse or pony.

• All competitors must be covered by their own 3rd party insurance.

• No irresponsible riding or behaviours to be exhibited on the show ground. The organisers retain the right to ask any competitor or spectator to remove themselves from the show ground for any reason.

• No competitors or spectators are to ride or walk down to the main yard.

• By paying to enter classes, all competitors or parents/guardians of those under 18 accept that: horse riding is a high risk sport & that injury may occur, that horses may act unpredictably on occasions; any instructions given by any official person(s) are to ensure horse and rider safety & must be followed by all; that competitors will always wear suitable safety wear whilst mounted; can be asked to leave at any time & must follow all orders by officials.

This is a fun show. Competition wear is not necessary, but is encouraged. Hard hats and suitable boots must be worn whilst mounted or in a ring with a horse. Cash only for entries on the day. 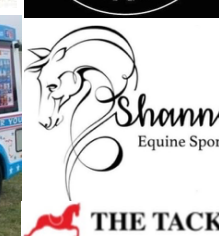

Parkinson's Disease is something that we still know little about. By raising money to help fund research into it, we hope to help change this.

Parkinson's is a progressive neurological condition, meaning it causes problems in the brain, getting worse over time. When you have Parkinson's, you have less dopamine due to some of the nerve cells that should produce it dying off, meaning movements can become slower. Symptoms most commonly associated with Parkinson's include tremors, stiffness & slowness of movement. Tremors often start out on 1 side of the body, but may spread as the disease progresses & they are probably the most well known symptom; however not everyone with Parkinson's will have a tremor. Those who suffer with muscle stiffness will find mobility such as turning around, getting out of chairs/ beds etc. much harder as well as fine motor movements such as writing or fastening buttons. People with Parkinson's may also experience non-motor symptoms such as tiredness, pain & memory problems.

It can be a debilitating disease if the symptoms lead to increased disability & poor health, as well as causing mild cognitive impairment.

In the UK there are around 127,000 people with the condition & each year about 10,000 people are diagnosed with it & anyone can get it, not just the elderly. It is the fastest growing neurological condition in the world!

There is no cure currently for Parkinson's Disease. Whilst researchers & scientists are making advances in understanding the condition, its causes and how best to treat it, no viable cure has yet been discovered, but thanks to people donating to this incredible charity research has made more progress towards finding a cure in the last decade than ever before.

By donating today you will help fund pioneering research into this disease which will help us to not only further understand this disease, but also how to help people manage the symptoms & hopefully one day soon how to cure Parkinson's disease altogether!
