Mini One Day Event.

Ring 3, Ring 4, Ring 5 and Ring 6.

To start at 10 AM.

Ring 3 will hold the jumping and **Ring 4** will hold the dressage. **Ring 5** will hold the arena XC / hunter style fences. **Ring 6** will hold the individual dressage. All will be held on grass. Entrants will be split junior and senior if entrants warrant. **Please state on entry if Junior, Senior or Lead rein.** The show jumping classes must be completed within 20 minutes of your dressage test. The XC must be completed within 20 minutes of your show jumping. The XC will be a mixture of working hunter / rustic and small XC fences. Approximately 8 jumps in each round. Numbers must be clearly visible at all times.

Dressage can be entered individually for £12 per test.

Clear round jumping / arena XC available in between classes if time allows, at the height already set, £5 per round. If wanting to do the clear round please present yourself at the ring and pay before you enter.

Entries £25 each class.

Class 26. Intro B, not exceeding 45cm jumping. Not exceeding 45cm working hunter, rustic fences. This class is for novice combinations and not to have won at prelim level or at 45cm or above. This class can be entered on lead rein, open to seniors and juniors (please state on entry).

Class 27. Intro C, not exceeding 55cm jumping, 55cm XC / hunter fences. Entries of class 27 not to have won at prelim level or jumping at 65cm or above.

Class 28. Prelim 1 (2006), not exceeding 70cm jumping, 70cm XC / hunter fences.

Class 29. Prelim 15 (2008), not exceeding 85cm jumping, 85cm XC / hunter fences.

Times will be sent via text or email on the Wednesday before the show.

Classes must be pre - entered apart from the clear round which can be paid for on the day at the ring side. Clear round is only open if time allows, for competitors already entered into the show and with paid up first aid. Dressage is pre - entry only, no entries allowed on the day.

Some classes will not run in class order. If you require your results posted then please bring a self addressed envelope and leave at the Secretary desk, alternatively you can leave £1 with your address.

Don't forget £2 first aid per rider.
