Class 1: 70-80cm PAIRS

The maximum height will be 80cm but there will be a range of jumps 70-80cm.

Traditional Hunter Trial course using our full course.

Class 5b: Gate Jumping Competition – SENIORS (Over 18) kindly sponsored by Mike and Bea.

This class is applicable for riders over the age of 18 years old at 1st Jan 2022. The gate height will start at 80cm, "Chase Me Charlie" thereafter. Riders will be allowed a practice fence before each attempt.

Entry fee: £20

- Entries close @ 5pm on Monday 29th August or when classes full
- No entries will be accepted on the day
- Late entries may be accepted NO later than Wednesday 31th August. This will be on a first come first served basing and ONLY if there are spaces.
- Individual start times will be available to view on Horse Events from 5pm on Friday 2nd September (times cannot be changed)
- All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online
- Refunds of entry free must be requested 48 hours before closing date (by Sat 27th Aug)

HUNTER TRIAL RULES (CLASSES 1-4)

- The decision of the organiser is final.
- No horse may run more than once in the same class
- All competitors are responsible for making way for faster horses and must ot obstruct other riders. Inconsiderate riding could lead to elimination, at the judge's discretion.
- 3 refusals at a fence is elimination, riders must leave the course at a walk.
- Cross Country attire to be worn including current standard body protector and hats. No fixed peaked hats.
- If at any time during the competition a horse appears to be unfit to continue, it may be eliminated on the authority of the veterinary surgeon or steward appointed for that purpose.
- In the event of a tie the prize money will be divided.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organizers or anyone
 for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organizers nor any agent, employee or
 representative of the AVHSC or Avon Vale Hunt accept any liability for any accident,
 loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars their
 contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused
 by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- Competitors must print their own number and bring their own number bib.

GATE JUMPING RULES (CLASSES 5A & 5B)

- The aim of the competition is to jump the gate without knocking it down. If it falls or you refuse then you may not continue.
- Hunting attire may be worn
- Body Protectors are advised
- The winner will be the combination to jump the highest gate
- The Judge's decision is final
- There will be a drawn order
- It is a knockout competition, three knockdowns or three refusals will result in elimination.
- The gate will be raised at the end of each round
- Competitors must wear a hard hat to the current approved British Safety Standards
