General Rules

- 1. All exhibitors must have adequate public liability insurance.
- 2. It is the exhibitors responsibility to check if the show is still taking place due to bad weather.
- 3. The organisers reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 4. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes.
- 5. The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage, injury or accident to spectators, exhibitors' or riders or their property as a result of attending this show. Please take appropriate care to prevent such accident or loss to yourselves and others.
- 6. The decision of the judge is final.
- 7. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted or handling horses. Minimum standard PAS 015 (1998, 2001 or 2011) and VG1 01.040 (2014-12) all with BSI Kitemark.
- 8. Objections or protest must be made in writing to the secretary accompanied by a fee of £25which may be forfeited to the show funds in the event of the objection being over ruled.
- 9. No litter is to be left on the show ground. CLEANING OUT OF HORSE BOXES AND TRAILERS IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.
- 10. Under no circumstances is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced.
- 11. All grooms entering the ring must be correctly dressed and must wear a hat in the ring (standard above).
- 12. Lead Rein competitors must be aged 3yo and over and lead rein must be fixed to the nose band. Snaffles only in lead rein classes.
- 13. No spurs allowed in Equitation classes.
- 14. No horse or pony to be left unattended tied outside a horsebox/trailer.
- 15. Whips not to exceed 75cms (30inc).
- 16. Due to **vehicle (4 ton axle) weight restrictions** on the show ground please can we ask all competitors, where possible, to arrive in a 4x4 and trailer or 3.5 ton horse box. Vehicles which appear to be overweight will be weighed and may be turned away.
- 17. The organisers retain the right to ask any rider to dismount if they are considered too heavy for the horse or pony being ridden.
- 18. May I remind everyone to please to please travel your horse/pony with their passport, it's the law (spot inspections may occur).
- 19. Colts and stallions must correctly bitted only be handled by anyone 18yo or over and must be identified with a ribbon in the tail and/or a bridle badge.
- 20. Mistreatment of any animal on the show ground will not be tolerated, the competitor/handler may be asked to leave the show ground.
- 21. Dogs must be kept on a lead AT ALL TIMES and cleaned up after. Barking dogs will be asked to be taken to a quiet place away from horses/ponies.
- 22. No canter/galloping outside of the competition and warm up rings.
- 23. No lunging anywhere on the show ground.

Horses and ponies are not to come onto the field if their flu injections are not up to date. Only horses and ponies who receive their yearly booster or horses/ponies who are restarting (must be 7days or more after their 2nd injection) will be permitted onto the show field. We may ask to see their passport to check their vaccination record.

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class. Competitors MUST have their qualification record sheet signed by judge/steward/secretary, record sheets are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at https://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/

NEW FUN CLASSES FOR 2022

Fun class - Novelty classes to be judged by 3 show attendees with a 'strictly come dance with me' style judging points. Held in the main arena around noon. Time will be confirmed closer to the day. £5 per class or £12 for all three.

Class N1 - Fancy dress - Best costume. Please ensure children are safe and horse/pony to be handled and/or ridden safely at all times.

Class N2 - Best trick - Can your equine kick a football? Hold a bucket? Pull a blanket off his back? Whatever their trick, come and show us.

Class N3 - Matching quadruple - Two equines and two handlers/riders. Everyone can be colour coordinated or sparkly or wearing pink spots! This class is to match as best you can, ridden or in hand.

*No trotting or cantering in these classes unless it is part of your 'tick' please see secretary when entering, thank you.

Each rider/handler must pay £2 towards first aid. You only pay this once.

*Classes are £10 before the day or £12 on the day. *

Discount on x4 classes -

A handler/rider booking x4 classes pays £35 instead of £40 (book before the day and can be used on more than one horse)

Every Rider/handler entered receives two tickets onto the fair.

- Class 13 Ridden foreign breeds Non native UK e.g Arab, PRE, Friesian etc
- Class 14 Riding club horse/pony, max jump height 50cm, will split class if sufficient entries.
