These will be given out randomly at the judge's decision, you do not necessarily have be placed 1st or even placed in a class to earn a ticket! These tickets are given out based on a range of details, such as riders who have made outstanding effort, horse and rider turn out, improvement throughout the day, overall willingness and sportsmanship. The idea of the golden ticket championship is to promote **FUN** back into showing, even when things don't go right! The lucky competitors to receive the golden tickets will then come forward to compete for the final judging, which will take place before the Supreme championships.

The Golden ticket champion will win a sash, rosette & MYSETERY CASH PRIZE.

Rules & Conditions upon entry to and competing at the Show

- 1. Current COVID 19 Rules and Regulations as per Government Guidelines on the day of the show applies.
- 2. It takes a lot of Time, Effort and background planning to put on this show, The Show and its Organisers, Landowner take NO RESPONSIBILITY for any Loss, Theft, Damage, Injury of any Persons or Animal including vehicles at the event.
- 3. Hard Hats to be worn when mounted at the show it is advised only British Standard (BS) approved hats are worn. (Strapless Helmets are not advised)
- 4. No Cantering or galloping outside the warm up area (This Will Be Strictly Applied)
- 5. The Judge's Decision Is Final Abuse towards Show Organisers, Stewards, Judges and anyone else assisting with the show will strictly **NOT** be tolerated and you will be asked to leave The Showground immediately.
- 6. Anyone seen to misuse the use of whips, spurs and or any III treatment of any animal will be asked to leave the Showground Immediately.
- **7.** Riders and Competitors to wear correct dress, Hard Hat, Jodhpurs/Breeches, Boots, Correct Show Attire.
- 8. Dogs must ALWAYS be kept on leads.
- 9. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their classes do not clash therefore no refunds will be given.
- 10. The Show Organisers have the right to refuse any entry for no given reason.
- 11. The Show Organisers reserve the right to make changes to the show and its schedule **At Any**Time.
- 12. All Persons on The Showground must follow instructions from Organiser's, Stewards, Judges and Landowner at all Times.
- 13. All ridden equines must be 4-year-old & over
- 14. Refunds no refunds can be made in any circumstances other than the discretion of the show committee
- 15. There is a photographer in attendance by entering the show ground you agree to have your pictures taken by the appointed photographer
- 16. All horses & ponies must have their annual vaccinations and passports may be checked
