RING 1: SHOW JUMPING RING (9:00am prompt)

There will be no points awarded to members for the clear round show-jumping.

Horses and ponies will compete together however placings and member's points will be awarded separately for horses and ponies.

Jump off straight after round

1. CLEAR ROUND SHOW JUMPING

(09:00am-10:00am)

The height of fences in this class will be between 40cm and 55cm. Entries for this class will close at 9:30am prompt.

2. 40CM SHOW JUMPING

This class is for genuine new jumpers and less confident combinations. Entry may be refused if it is felt you are using this class as a warm up! Lead rein riders welcome. The maximum height of fences will be 40cm.

3. 55CM SHOW JUMPING

The maximum height of fences will be 55cm.

4. 65CM SHOW JUMPING

The maximum height of fences will be 65cm.

NOT TO START BEFORE 12:00PM

5. Pairs

All jumps 65cm – 75cm

6. 75CM SHOW JUMPING

The maximum height of fences will be 75cm.

7. 85CM SHOW JUMPING

The maximum height of fences will be 85cm.

8. 95CM SHOW JUMPING

The maximum height of fences will be 95cm. Fences in this class will be a little more challenging and some elements will be fully up to height and width.

RING 2: WORKING HUNTER RING (10:00am prompt)

Horses and ponies will compete together however separate rosettes will be given for horses and ponies.

Ponies 15hh and under. Horses 15hh and over

Marks knock down 10, 1st refusal 15, 2nd refusal 20, 3rd elimination

9. LEAD REIN

This class is for Lead rein riders. The maximum height of fences will be 30cm.

10. FIRST RIDDEN WORKING HUNTER. PONY ONLY

This class is for genuine new jumpers and less confident combinations. Maximum height of fences 55cm

11. 55CM WORKING HUNTER PONY

This class is for genuine new jumpers and less confident combinations. Entry may be refused if it is felt you are using this class as a warmup! The maximum height of fences will be 50cm. All riders must be off the lead rein.

MID-MORNING CHAMPIONSHIPS

1ST and 2nd places from classes 8, 9, & 10.

Welcome to enter mid morning champion.

Winner and reserve will then compete for the overall Supreme Championship at the end of the day.

NOT TO START BEFORE 12:00PM

12. 65CM WORKING HUNTER HORSE / PONY

The maximum height of fences will be 65cm

13. 75CM WORKING HUNTER HORSE / PONY

The maximum height of fences will be 75cm

14. 85CM – 90CM WORKING HUNTER HORSE / PONY

The maximum height of fences will be 90cm and fillers will be used.

RING 3: RIDDEN RING (9:00am prompt)

15. BEST TURNED OUT HORSE AND PONY

Lead rein entries welcome.

16. LEAD REIN BEST RIDDEN

Class is open to all breeds. Riders to be 9 years and under.

17. BEGINNERS / FIRST RIDDEN

Riders to be 12 years and under.

18. NOVICE COMBINATIONS Walk & Trot Only

This class is for genuine new and less confident combinations.

19. BEST RIDDEN PONY

Open to all ponies. Rider any age

MID-MORNING CHAMPIONSHIPS

1ST and 2nd places from classes 15, 16, 17, 18 & 19

Welcome to enter mid morning championship.

Winner and reserve will then compete for the overall Supreme Championship at the end of the day.

NOT TO START BEFORE 1.00PM

20. BEST RIDDEN HORSE

Open to all horses. Rider any age

21. RIDDEN COLOURED HORSE OR PONY

Judged 50% horse's manners and way of going, 25% conformation and 25% turnout

22. M&M SMALL AND LARGE BREED (NO PART BREDS)

There WILL be separate rosettes for both small and large breeds

23. RIDDEN COB

Traditional or Trimmed

24. VETERAN HORSE OR PONY

15 years +

25. RIDDEN HUNTER

Judged 50% horse's way of going, 25% conformation,

AFTERNOON CHAMPIONSHIPS

1ST and 2nd places from classes 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 & 25.

Welcome to enter afternoon championship. Winner and reserve will then compete for the overall Supreme Championship at the end of the day.

RING 4: IN-HAND RING (9:30am prompt)

26. CONDITION AND TURN OUT

Open to all horses and ponies

27. COLOURED HORSE / PONY

Open to skewbald, piebald, roan, and spotted horses and ponies.

28. M&M SMALL AND LARGE BREED (NO PART BREDS)

To be shown in natural state. Separate rosettes for both small and large breeds. The class WILL be split.

29. IN HAND COB

Class is open to trimmed and traditional cobs

30. VETERAN HORSE OR PONY

Open to horses and ponies aged 15 years and over

31. OPEN HORSE

Open to horses any age

MID-MORNING CHAMPIONSHIPS

1ST and 2nd places from classes 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 & 31.

Welcome to enter mid morning championship. Winner and reserve will then compete for the overall Supreme Championship at the end of the day.

NOT TO START BEFORE 1.00PM

32. YOUNG HANDLER

This class will be split into handlers aged 9 years and under, and handlers aged 10 to 16 years.

33. BONNY PONY

Ponies to be 14.2hh and under

34. HANDSOME GELDING

Geldings to be aged 4 years +.

35. PRETTIEST MARE

Mares to be 4 years +

AFTERNOON CHAMPIONSHIPS

1ST and 2nd places from classes 32, 33, 34 & 35.

Welcome to enter afternoon championship. Winner and reserve will then compete for the overall Supreme Championship at the end of the day.

SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

Champion and reserve champion from mid-morning and afternoon championships. Ridden, working hunter & In-hand.

EDRC RULES 2022

These rules are displayed on the entries caravan and are also available on the website or by post. By entering onto the EDRC field it is understood that you have read, understand and agree to abide by the following:

- Horses and ponies will compete in the same show-jumping classes; however there will be separate sets of rosettes for horses and ponies.
- Lead rein competitors may enter the ridden veteran, coloured and hunter classes.
- Lead rein competitors must be in a snaffle bridle with the lead rein attached to the noseband.
- All ages are as at 1 January 2022.
- Junior riders are aged 16 years and under.
- Senior riders are aged 17 years and over.
- All handlers and riders of stallions or colts must be 16 years old and over.
- All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
- EDRC does not have a height limit for lead rein or first ridden ponies/horses, unless stated.
- Approved BHS/BRC headgear with chin strap fastened must be worn by all mounted riders. Details of the new BRC Guidelines can be found in the caravan, on the website, and on Facebook.
- Competitors must enter the ring suitably attired.
- The decision of the Judge is final. Appeals must be submitted within 15 minutes of the class ending and be accompanied by a £20 fee, which may be returned if the appeal is upheld. Appeals will be deliberated at the next Committee meeting and a decision given thereafter. Appeals will not be discussed on the day of the show.
- EDRC take pride in being a friendly Riding Club, encouraging good sportsmanship and behaviour. We have a zero tolerance policy covering any member found to be in breach of this towards other members, competitors, visitors and animals both on and off the showground, and including social networking sites.
- No Spurs for any equitation class. No child under 16 allowed to wear spurs. No spurs on ponies.
- Working hunter pony 15hh under. Working hunter horse 15.1 and over
- Class bundle MUST be the same rider / handler and horse / pony

EDRC RULES 2022 – MEMBER SPECIFIC

- Membership runs from January 2022 to December 2022 costing £20 per person.
- Membership is per rider / leader
- Points are only awarded to members
- Same combination must enter class twice to count towards point system

DIRECTIONS TO THE EDRC SHOW GROUND - S21 5RU

From Junction 30 M1 take the A6135 towards Eckington. Follow the road for approximately 3 miles, through Renishaw, past the Sitwell Arms on the right, and then the golf course. At the crossroads with the traffic lights turn left onto the B6056 and continue through Eckington village. You will pass Eckington Comprehensive School on the right, and the Fox and Hounds pub on the left. Continue up the hill and through Marsh Lane. The show ground is ¼ mile past the Butchers Arms pub and then School Lane, on the right hand side at the junction of Main Road and Quarry Hill. Turn right onto Quarry Hill and the show field is the first double gate on the right.

Please do not park on the roadside.
