

- 2. Hard hats with chin straps fastened and boots with heels must be worn at all times by anyone mounted on the showground. Failure to do so will incur elimination from the show. Headgear must conform to ,PAS015:1998 or 2011, VG1, ASTM F116304, AS/NZS38 2003 must have CE Label & BS kite mark. SNELL E2001 with official snell label & number. Must be eligible to read.
- 3. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times on the showground.
- 4. The Judge's and/or organisers' decision is final in **all** cases. The organisers may refuse entry without giving a reason.
- 5. The Judges reserve the right to eliminate any unsound or unfit horse/pony.
- 6. Any person seen ill-treating a horse/pony will be asked to leave.
- 7. Showing exhibitors are reminded that classes in Rings 3 and 4 are intended solely for riders amateurs exhibitors and for novice horses/ponies which are home-produced. ie. not stabled, schooled with a professional rider/trainer.
