

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- All horses and ponies **MUST** have at least a Yearly Booster jab, or 2nd lot of Jabs if they have never been vaccinated before/ had to start a new course of vaccinations. You may be asked to present a passport/ proof of vaccinations from a vet.
- Please act responsibly; if your horse is showing signs of equine flu, strangles or any other illness or contagion, or you are showing signs of/ have been in contact with anyone who has Covid-19, please do not attend, for the safety of everyone.
- Due to Health & Safety regulations, NO horses or ponies are to be tied up to the sides of lorries or trailers & left unattended at any time.
- The Organisers accept no responsibility for any accident, loss, or damage to any competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or property; it shall be condition of entry that competitors will hold organisers blameless & indemnify them against any loss, damage or legal proceedings.
- **Hard hats to current safety standards are to be worn & fastened at all times whilst mounted. It is advised that body protectors are worn for jumping classes.**
- No horses under the age of 4 to be ridden on the show ground, no children under the age of 2 to compete, no horses under 1 year old to attend. Stallions/colts must be adequately under control & not exhibited by anyone under the age of 16.
- No cantering nor lunging around the horseboxes/ trailers. All other warmup must be done in consideration to other competitors, spectators & officials. Warm up is also done at your own risk. Any injury to horse or rider is to be accepted as your own responsibility, not the fault of the Organisers.
- We do our best to maintain the ground at a high standard, weather permitting, however please remain cautious & ride sensibly. It is part of our yard turnout, so we cannot always cut the grass extremely short, or keep it perfectly flat.
- No mucking out of horseboxes or trailers on the showground.
- All rubbish is to be put in the bins provided, or your own vehicles, not left on the showground.
- Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times & any fouling to be cleaned up. No aggressive or uncontrollable dogs allowed.
- Standard tack only, no severe spurs, bits or aids allowed.
- **The judges' decisions are final. Please do not abuse any of our judges in any way.**
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter any classes, the event, or refuse entries. No refunds given unless classes are cancelled. Afternoon classes not starting exactly on time is not a reason for refund- start times are only approximate & tell you afternoon classes will not start BEFORE, not AT specific times.
- Any complaints must be made in writing & accompanied by £15 deposit within 15 minutes of the end of the class, refundable if the complaint is upheld.
- Competitors and spectators are responsible for their own health & safety, in the event of an accident, an ambulance will be called. If anyone sustains a head injury, they will not be permitted to get back on any horse or pony.
- All competitors must be covered by their own 3rd party insurance.
- No irresponsible riding or behaviours to be exhibited on the show ground. The organisers retain the right to ask any competitor or spectator to remove themselves from the show ground for any reason.
- No competitors or spectators are to ride or walk down to the main yard.
- By paying to enter classes, all competitors or parents/guardians of those under 18 accept that: horse riding is a high risk sport & that injury may occur, that horses may act unpredictably on occasions; any instructions given by any official person(s) are to ensure horse and rider safety & must be followed by all; that competitors will always wear suitable safety wear whilst mounted; can be asked to leave at any time & must follow all orders by officials.

This is a fun show. Competition wear is not necessary, but is encouraged. Hard hats and suitable boots must be worn whilst mounted or in a ring with a horse. Cash only for entries on the day. How It Works:

Jumping & Dressage Qualifier Dates:

Tuesday 28th May ~ pre-entry only for ALL classes

Tuesday 11th June ~ pre-entry only for ALL classes

Sunday 30th June ~ must pre-enter at least 1 class

Sunday 14th July ~ must pre-enter at least 1 class

Tuesday 23rd July ~ pre-entry only for ALL classes

Sunday 11th August ~ must pre-enter at least 1 class

Tuesday 20th August ~ pre-entry only for ALL classes

We will also be holding Jumping Qualifier classes at our fun shows on Sunday 19th May & Sunday 8th September

Summer League Championship Show:

Sunday 22nd September

Tuesday classes will only have limited entries as they are running in the evening, so pre-enter early.

You will gain points per horse & rider combination in each class you compete in.

1st place = 7 points

2nd place = 6 points

3rd place = 5 points

4th place = 4 points

5th place = 3 points

6th place = 2 points

Anyone who turns up to compete, but doesn't get placed will still receive 1 point.

You will need 15 points per horse & rider combination in each class you'd like to enter to qualify for the championship. Wildcards may be given depending on numbers.

The championship show will have 1st-6th in each class. We will also be giving out some additional points-based prizes, including a points champion in each class, so keep an eye on the points tables throughout the league (will be posted on our Facebook Page & Instagram). The championship show will be pre-entry only.

Show Jumping

Entry Fee: £5 per class.

For Tuesday shows it'll be **pre-entry only**- class numbers will be limited.

For Sunday shows, you **MUST** pre-enter at least **1** class overall (jumping or dressage) to enter the show, but additional jumping classes may be entered on the day. Jumping entries close **3 days before** each show.

Bring exact change for on the day. Rosettes to 6th.

Class 5 **Up to 1'6 (No Spreads)** ~ any horse & rider combination who has not been placed 1st-2nd with us before January 2024

Class 6 **1'9** ~ any horse & rider combination who has not been placed 1st-2nd with us before January 2024

Class 7 **2'**

Class 8 **2'3**

Class 9 **2'6**

Class 10 **2'9**

We will be running a limited amount of clear round before classes start on Sundays, £3 for one go, £5 for two.

On Tuesdays the classes will start at 5pm & be run as one round with a timed section, on Sundays they will start at 10am & there will be an initial round followed by a jump off for all clears.

How It Works

Tuesday Shows:

Will run from 5pm onwards. All classes will be pre-entry only, as classes will be limited, so book early to avoid disappointment.

Entries close 1 week before each show. Late entries may be accepted if spaces are still available, at an additional £2 per class, but this is not guaranteed. Jumping classes will be run as a single phase, with a timed section.

We may allow a small number of pre-entered clear rounds/ Give-it-a-go dressage entries prior to 5pm.

Sunday Shows:

Will run from 10am onwards. Dressage classes will be pre-entry only & entries close 1 week before each show.

For jumping classes you must pre-enter at least one class per person overall (jumping or dressage), but additional jumping classes may be entered on the day. Jumping entries close 3 days before each show. Jumping classes will include both an initial round and then a timed jump-off for all clears.

There will be a limited amount of clear round and also Give-it-a-go dressage available. Give-it-a-go dressage must also be pre-entered, let us know which 20x40m intro, prelim, or novice test you would like to ride when entering.

Competition wear is not necessary, but all tack for dressage classes must be BD Legal. Tests may be called for all classes.

We will only be using pre-2024 dressage tests for this year's league. We will not be incorporating any of the new tests at this time- please be sure to learn the correct test.
