Class 1: BD Intro A (2008) 20m x 40m arena

Class 2: BD Prelim 1 (2006) 20m x 40m arena

Class 3: BD Prelim 14 (2006) 20m x 40m arena

Class 4: BD Novice 30 (2006) 20m x 40m arena

Class 5: BD Short Arena Elementary, Medium or Adv Med 20m x 40m arena

Section a: Elementary 42; Section b: Medium 63; Section c: Adv Med 93

Classes 4 – results for each section are combined and placings decided based on the percentage scored. Riders can do multiple tests in each of the PYO classes (entry fee for each). This does not affect qualification for Championships in the Elementary tests.

Intro to Elementary level tests are Hartpury and Trailblazers Qualifiers

Combined Training

Entry Fee: £25 per class

Class 6: Pick and Mix Combined Training: Pick a short arena test offered in the above Dressage competition and pick a Show Jumping height from 30cm to 1m. Please put your nominated dressage test and show jumping height in the notes section of your entry. Please note that the placings will not be available until all dressage tests and SJ rounds are completed. You may be asked to do your dressage test at the start of the day to fit in with the Show Jumping running order.

Trailblazers Combined Training Qualifiers

To be eligible for a Trailblazers qualification letter, you must select:

Prelim Dressage & 60cm Show Jumping

Novice Dressage & 70cm Show Jumping

Elementary Dressage & 80cm Show Jumping

All other test levels/heights are non-qualifying combinations.

All classes may be combined for results if low entries but this does not affect qualifying opportunities.

All tests may be called.

CLASS 22: Mini (20-30cm)

May be on the Lead Rein/Assisted or Unassisted

Dressage Test: Pony Club D-Level Walk & Trot Test (2012) - Whips allowed

No back poles in show jumping course. Shorted XC course, fences approx. 20 – 30cm.

CLASS 23: Intro (Approx. 40cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage Test: Intro A (2008) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 24: Novice (Approx. 50cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage Test: Prelim 1 (2006) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 25: Novice Plus (Approx. 60cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: Prelim 1 (2006) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 26: Intermediate (Approx. 70cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: Prelim 14 (2006) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 27: Open (Approx. 80cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: Prelim 14 (2006) - Whips allowed.

CLASS 28: Open Plus (Approx. 90cm)

No assistance other than calling the test

Dressage test: Prelim 14 (2006) - Whips allowed.

CLOSING DATE: The Wednesday before the competition. If classes are full before the closing date, then a waiting list will be held.

TIMES: Start lists with times are posted on My Riding Life; by the evening of the Friday before the competition.

PRIZEGIVING: Please collect from the Secretary's box after the end of the class – please allow time for other competitors to finish (including late entries) and for scores to be finalised. Rosettes: to sixth place

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
3. All competitors must have their own third-party cover. Please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.

RULES AND NOTICES

1. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Secretary (either before the times are published or at the Secretary's box on the day). No changes will be made once times are published.
2. Pre-entries are essential for dressage. If you miss the closing date please email the Secretary for available spaces.
3. Closing date for entries – Wednesday before the competition. Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary within a week of the competition (please enclose an s.a.e.). Refunds will be minus an administration charge.
4. If the show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded via Stripe – this can take up to 10 working days. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.
5. TIMES WILL BE GIVEN – please see your My Riding Life account.
6. Please collect numbers and pay first aid prior to warming up.
7. Children must not ride in the warm-up arena without an accompanying adult.
8. Each combination may only compete once in each class, with the exception of PYO classes. Stallions are allowed only with prior permission from the Entries Secretary and must wear stallion discs. All horse/ponies must be at least 4 years old on day of competition.
9. Turnout for ALL riders and horses is per BRC or Trailblazers rulebooks.
10. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
11. We sometimes get withdrawals so it really helps if you can be ready to ride your test approx. 10 mins before the time shown.

12. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not want your photograph taken, please notify the photographer on the day.

13. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park. Please be aware that there is no gate between the lorry park and the main road.

14. **All classes are run under British Riding Club and Trailblazers Rules.**

15. The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor behaving in such a manner as to breach these rules.

16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or alter the order of classes if there are insufficient entries.

17. Requests with regards to times can be declared in your entry notes and the organisers will do their best to accommodate these.

18. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

19. Please abide by all signage and follow instructions from Tumpy Green staff.
