Travelling on the A1033 heading towards Patrington, as you enter the village of Thorngumbald, the Show field is on the left-hand side with the entrance to the field just before the '30 miles per-hour' speed sign.

Travelling on the A1033 heading towards Hull, as you come out of the village of Thorngumbald just after the cemetery on the right-hand side, the Show field in on the right with the entrance just after the '40 miles per-hour' speed sign.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, except in the dog classes requiring 'off lead' work.

Please pick up any dog faeces from the show field and use the bins provided.

DO NOT empty horse droppings from trailers/lorries onto the show field – please remove horse droppings from near your trailer/lorry.

The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person(s), to alter any class and to limit class entries to a suitable number. They also reserve the right to amalgamate classes if there are insufficient entries.

Entries on the day only to be paid by cash – no cheques or IOUs, sorry. Entries on the day will not be refunded. Online entries will be refunded in the event of cancellation of the Show, excluding the admin fee.

Any objection should be lodged with the secretary (accompanied by £50) within 10 minutes of the end of the class, not refundable if the objection is overruled.

Competitors must wear riding hats showing the relevant quality symbol/kite mark at all times when mounted.

Ring 1 - Ridden Fun Classes (£6 entry)

1pm prompt (may be held in a different ring – listen for the announcements)

Fancy Dress Open to juniors and seniors, horses and ponies – if sufficient entries, juniors (16 years old and under) and seniors (17 years old and over) will be placed separately. Please note: Riding hats must be worn in the fancy dress class.

Class 13	My Best Friend – rider 12 years and under – tell the judge why your pony is your best friend
Class 14	Bonny Girls (Mare)
Class 15	Bonny Boys (Gelding)
Class 16	Happy Hacker Class – horse/pony any height, rider any age – there will be a few hazards to assess i.e cones and an area to perform a halt. Riders are encouraged to wear hi-vis to promote safety on the roads – the more hi-vis the better (this may get you a bonus prize!)
Class 17	Best Figure of Eight in Trot – horse/pony any height, rider any age

Class 22a	Ridden Coloured - Piebald/Skewbald, rider any age, horse any height Traditional/Native – to be shown in natural state/hogged
Class 22b	Ridden Coloured - Piebald/Skewbald, rider any age, horse any height Non-native – to be shown plaited and trimmed
Class 23	Ridden All Other Colours –, rider any age, horse any height (bay, grey, chestnut, black, dun, roan, appaloosa, palomino, etc. excluding Piebald/Skewbald)

Ring 3 – Working Hunter Classes (£8 entry)

N.B All fence heights are approximate.

Working Hunter Classes involve jumping a short course of rustic fences, followed by a short show to include a walk, trot and canter on each rein and possibly a gallop. Judging is based on style, way of going and conformation.

Working Hunter Clear Round – jump a course of fences at a height to suit you. Have a chat with the stewards to find out what a Working Hunter Class is all about. Rosettes to all clear rounds. £4 per round – pay at the ring
