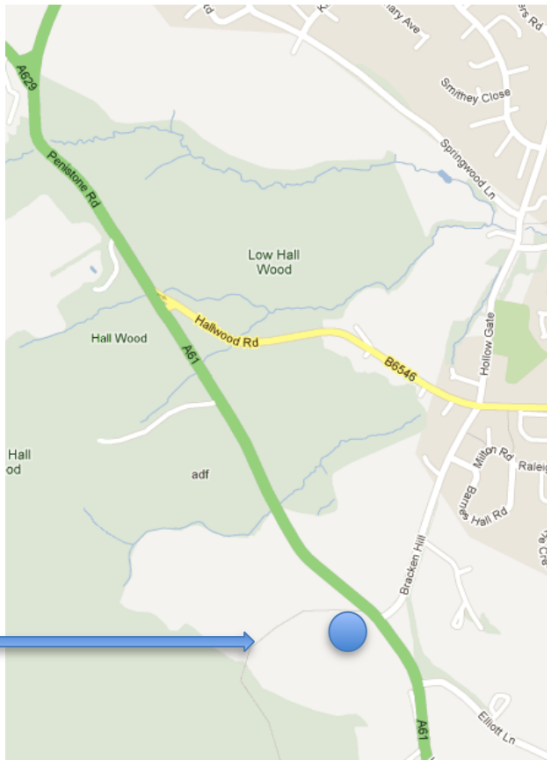
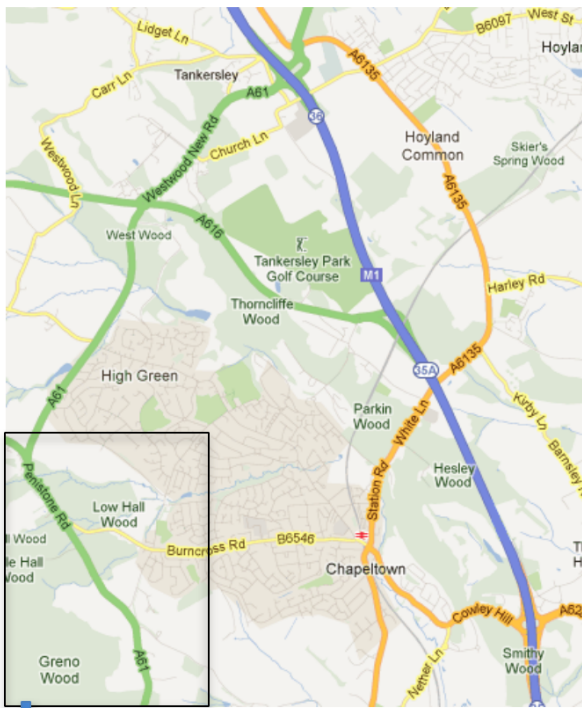

E.D.E.C RULES

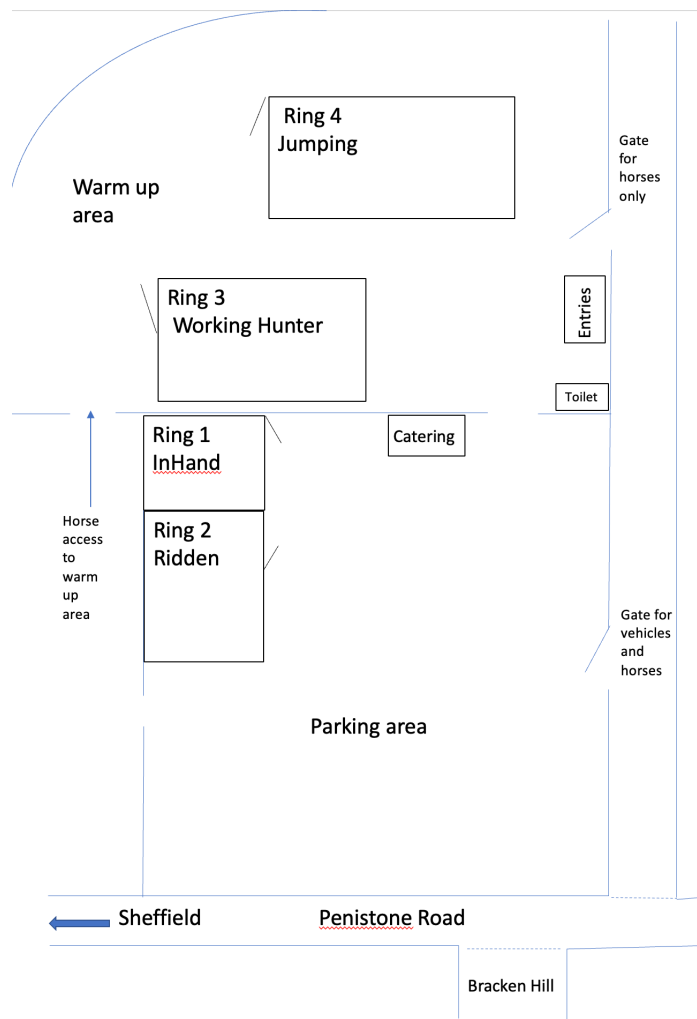
- All owners entering their horses/ponies do so at their own risk. E.D.E.C, its officers, members and landowners accept no liability of any kind in respect of accident, damage, injury or illness to animals, owners, riders, grooms or spectators or any person, property what so ever.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Hard hats to current standards must be worn at all times when riding, mounting or dismounting, along with appropriate footwear.
- The organisers also recommend that a current standard body protector is worn when jumping.
- Juniors are aged 16 & under as at 1st January 2024. Seniors are aged 17 & over as at 1st January 2024.
- Ponies are 14.2hh and under; horses are over 14.3hh and over
- No standing martingales to be used in any class involving jumping.
- Spurs may NOT be worn by anyone 16 or under.
- Excessive use of crop or spurs or any other abuse may result in elimination.
- No horse or pony under the age of 4 is allowed to participate in jumping classes.
- All handlers & riders of stallions or colts must be 17 years or older.
- No cantering or galloping on the show field unless in one of the competitors rings or warm-up area.
- All competitors must act in a responsible manner to other competitors and judges.
- The organisers reserve the right at any time to cancel, amalgamate or split any class.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure they meet the criteria for the class. You may be disqualified if you enter a class which you are not qualified to enter.
- It is the competitor's responsibility to be ready to enter the ring; we cannot be expected to come and find you.
- We do not give refunds unless the class is cancelled.
- Any objections must be lodged at the entries tent with a £20 deposit within 15 minutes of the class ending, the deposit will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- Any abusive behaviour will not be tolerated – you will be disqualified from any more classes and asked to leave the show immediately.
- No mucking out on the field. Please take your rubbish home with you.
- All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Please use doggy bags & take them home.
- Any violation of the above rules may result in disqualification from any or all classes.
- Bitless bridles are allowed in any class.
