### **Class 1 - 30cm**

All jumps will be cross pole except the last jump in phase one and the last jump in the jump off.

### **Class 2 - 40cm**

All jumps will be cross poles in this class. Lead rein or support will be allowed.

### **Class 3 - 50cm**

Jumps in this class will be a mix of cross and straights.

All ridden horses/ponies to be at least 4 years old. All horses/ponies must carry a valid passport and have it available should it be required. Excessive use of whips or spurs will result in the rider being escorted off the showground with no refund.

No whips to exceed 75cm. No entry fee will be refunded once the entry is made. HATS-BHS approved helmets must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times by any mounted rider and competitors must enter the ring wearing the correct attire for the discipline. The decision of the judges or committee is final.

All complaints are to be made to the secretary with a fee of £10 and must be made within 10 minutes of the class finishing. We may in our absolute discretion, refuse to accept any entry, the entry will be returned with any fee and no correspondence will be entered into with regard to the non-acceptance.

Spectators are reminded that horses and ponies can be unpredictable and to take care of themselves and their children at all times. People behaving inappropriately will be warned, if the behaviour continues they will be asked to leave the venue and escorted from the showground. Please ensure all spectators are aware of the potential hazards around horses.

All participants are reminded of the importance of safe conduct at all times, and are advised to wear protective clothing up to the current standards. They are also reminded that they take part entirely at their own risk and must have public liability insurance cover.

Notice is hereby given that Thornberry Animal Sanctuary and organisers accept no liability for any accident, injury, illness, damage to any horse, pony, rider, owner, spectator, leader or any other person on the property whatsoever.
