RING 1 – SHOWING CLASSES TO START 9.30AM

All classes £9.00 in advance (£10.00 on the day)

Class 1 BEST TURNED OUT OPEN RIDDEN

Including lead rein

Class 2 LEAD REIN PONY

Not exceeding 12.2hh. Suitable for and to be ridden by children 8 years and under. Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle. The same rider and pony combinations cannot compete in classes 2 and 3.

Class 3 FIRST RIDDEN PONY

Not exceeding 12.2hh. Suitable for and to be ridden by children 10 years and under off the leading rein. No cantering except for individual show (optional). Ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle. The same rider and pony combination cannot compete in classes 2 and 3.

Class 4 BEST FAMILY HORSE/PONY

Riders will be asked to give a short show including a small jump that may be altered at the discretion of the judge. To be judged on show, manners and suitability for the rider.

Confirmation not considered. Horses and ponies any height. Riders any age.

Class 5 BEST PONY CLUB PONY

Not exceeding 14.2hh, 4 years old and over. Showing will include a jump.

Class 6 IN HAND MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND – ALL BREEDS

Welsh A and B, Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Welsh C and D, New Forest, Fell, Connemara, Dales, Highland. Class may be split to small and large breeds if entries permit. To be shown in hand.

Class 7 IN HAND NON–NATIVE/FOREIGN BREEDS

Horses or ponies who are of a registered breed not native to the UK. Breeds may include, but not limited to Haflinger, Fjord, Arabs, Friesians, Warmbloods etc. To be shown in hand.

Class 8 RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND – ALL BREEDS

Welsh A and B, Shetland, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Welsh C and D, New Forest, Fell, Connemara, Dales, Highland. Class may be split to small and large breeds if entries permit.

Class 9 RIDDEN NON–NATIVE/FOREIGN BREEDS

Horses or ponies who are of a registered breed not native to the UK. Breeds may include, but not limited to Haflinger, Fjord, Arabs, Friesians, Warmbloods etc

RING 2–SHOWING CLASSES TO START 9.30AM

All classes £9.00 in advance (£10.00 on the day)

Class 10 RIDDEN HUNTER

Exceeding 14.2hh, 4 years old and over.

Class 11 RIDDEN HUNTER PONY

Not exceeding 14.2hh, 4 years old and over. Lead Rein and First Ridden Welcome.

Class 12 BEST RIDING CLUB HORSE

Exceeding 14.2hh, 4 years old and over.

Class 13 BEST RIDDEN COB

Trimmed or hairy. Class may be split if entries permit.

Class 14 COLOURED HORSE OR PONY IN HAND

All colours permitted.

Class 15 VETERAN IN HAND

Horse or Pony 17 years or older.

Class 16 COLOURED HORSE OR PONY RIDDEN

All colours permitted.

Class 17 VERETAN RIDDEN

Horse or pony 17 years or older.

Class 18 RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE

Racehorses to riding horses need not necessarily have raced; however, all horses must have been in training at some time and registered with Wetherbys. To be assessed on conformation, manners and way of going.

RING 3–UNAFFILIATED SHOW JUMPING TO START 9.30AM

Judge – Mrs L. Dawson. All classes £9.00 in advance (£10.00 on the day)

Classes 19 - 26 to be jumped as unaffiliated single phase. Open to horses and ponies, classes may be split if entries permit. Combinations taking part in classes 24 – 27 may not enter classes 19 – 22 and vice versa.

- Class 19** **LEAD REIN JUMPING** – Fences 30cm max. Cross poles and no fillers. Novice riders on lead rein.
- Class 20** **SMALL ASSISTED JUMPING** – Fences 30cm max. Cross poles and no fillers. Aimed at novice combinations just off the lead rein. Riders can be assisted in the ring but not be led around the entire course.
- Class 21** **ASSISTED JUMPING** – Fences 45cm max. Riders can be assisted in the ring but not led around the entire course.
- Class 22** **VERY NOVICE JUMPING** – Fences 50cm max, No spreads. Unassisted, combinations not to have won an unassisted show jumping competition.
- Class 23** **PAIRS JUMPING** - Fences 50cm max. Rider 1 to jump first half of the course, rider 2 to jump second half of the course with whip handover within a box. Course to be confirmed on the day.
- Class 24** **60cm JUMPING**
- Class 25** **70cm JUMPING**
- Class 26** **80cm JUMPING**
- Class 27** **CHASE ME CHARLIE** – One fence to be jumped only. This will be raised with each round. Those rider/horse combinations that jump clear proceed to the next round, with the highest clear round jump declared the winner.

RING 4 -CLEAR ROUND SHOW JUMPING TO START 9AM- 2PM

Entries on the day. Pay on the day available at £5.00 per round to include rosette.

You must have a competitor number from the secretary (unless already been allocated one) before you can compete.

RING 5- HANDY PONY TO START 10AM– 1PM

Classes 28-30 £5.00. Class 31 – Free Entry.

HANDY PONY RIDDEN. If you are entering on the day, you must have a competitor number from the secretary (unless already been allocated one) before you can compete.

- Class 28** **HANDY PONY LEAD REIN**
Class 29 **HANDY PONY OPEN**
Class 30 **HANDY PONY IN HAND** Open to any age horse/pony

Prizes in Kind. Rosettes to 6th place and special rosette to all competitors.

- Class 31** **FANCY DRESS** – Not to start before 1pm. **To assemble and parade in front of the marquee for judging.** Ridden or in hand. All riders must wear a current standard approved helmet and boots with a heel.

RING 6- NOVELTY CLASSES TO START 10.30AM

All classes £5.00 in advance (£6.00 on the day). Classes will be split if entries allow. All classes may be ridden or in hand.

- Class 32** **CHEEKIST PONY FACE**
Class 33 **MOST HANDSOME GELDING**
Class 34 **PRETTIEST MARE**
Class 35 **PONY THE JUDGE WOULD LIKE TO TAKE HOME**
Class 36 **BEST YOUNG HANDLER**
Class 37 **BEST RIDER 10 YEARS AND UNDER**
Class 38 **BEST RIDER 16 YEARS AND UNDER**

GYMKHANA NOT TO START NOT BEFORE 1.30PM

Gymkhana to start following the fancy dress class parade.

Entries on the day only taken at the secretaries in advance or at the ringside £10 per class. You must have a competitor number from the secretary (unless already been allocated one) before you can compete.

Races may include bending, mug race, ride & run, etc. Max 4 races per class.

Rosettes to 4th place in the heats and 6th place for each class with an overall Championship to be awarded at the end.

- Class 39** Riders 7 and under – leading rein allowed
Class 40 Riders 10 years and under – assistance allowed
Class 41 Riders 14 years and under

RING 7 - DRESSAGE

Times will be available online or from the secretary on Wednesday 17th July 2024 after 4pm. All dressage classes £10.00 each

Class 42 **BD DRESSAGE TEST - INTRO A** - Assisted – can be on lead rein/assistant in the ring

Class 43 **BD DRESSAGE TESTS – INTRO A** - Non-Assisted

Riders any age. Horse/pony any height.

Prizes in kind to the winners of each section.

Class 44 **BD Dressage Test – PRELIM 12 (2005) Revised 2016**

Riders any age. Horse/pony any height. Rosette awarded to the highest placed Ex-Racehorse and Highest Placed Junior – **you must please inform the secretary on the day if you are eligible for either of these.**

Prizes in kind to the winner.

RING 8 - NOVELTY FUN DOG SHOW TO START 1.30PM

To start following the fancy dress.

Entries taken via Secretary on the day and then at the ringside from 12.30pm. Entry £3.00 per dog per class.

Class 1 Best Puppy up to 12 months old.

Class 2 Best small dog (excluding puppies) under 18”.

Class 3 Best large dog over 18”.

Class 4 Veteran dog over 7 years old.

Class 5 Happiest dog with the waggiest tail.

Class 6 Dog in best condition.

Class 7 Young Handler 6yrs to 16yrs.

Class 8 Best rescue dog

Class 9 Best six legs

RULES FOR THE SHOW

1. The Show Committee and Landowner do not accept any responsibility or liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any person, animal or property whatsoever arising out of this show.
2. The decision of the Judges is final
3. Objections must be handed to the secretary within 30 minutes of the incident with £100 deposit. The deposit will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
4. Refunds will only be given on production of a valid Veterinary or Doctor's certificate 14 days prior to the show. A fee of £4 for admin will be held by the show.
5. The Committee reserves the right to alter or cancel any class and to refuse any entry.
6. First aid cover will be £2 per competitor to assist with the cost of the First Aid Cover.
7. Anyone mounted must wear hats complying with standard PAS015 (2011), VG1 01.040 2014-12 provided they are BSI kitemarked or Inspec IC Mark. It is recommended that everyone (especially 16yrs and under) showing in hand must also wear a hard hat as above with a secure fitting chin strap. Body protectors are recommended.
8. Horses must only be walking on the showground unless they are in the collecting ring to warm up.
9. Galloping is strictly forbidden.
10. Jackets and proper riding boots must be worn in the showing ring.
11. No misuse of the whip will be allowed.
12. Any outside assistance, bad language to other competitors, judges or officials will incur elimination.
13. All dogs must be kept on a lead and cleared up after. Please note Rush Farm is a working farm with livestock around.
14. The practice fence must only be jumped in the direction flagged and at the appropriate height for the class.
15. Competitors are responsible for having their own insurance in place.
16. No stallion to be led or ridden by any person under 16years.
17. If you are competing or attending on your own then it is your responsibility to ensure the secretary has a contact detail for your preferred person in case of emergency.
18. All horses and ponies must have had a vaccination certificate issued with the last 12 months. This must be available for inspection should it be required.
19. Please ensure all rubbish and muck is taken home.
20. In the event that the competition has to be cancelled, the entry fee will be refunded minus a £4 admin fee.
21. It is the competitor's responsibility to keep in contact with the show to ensure they do not miss a class if classes are running slightly ahead from the approximate timetable issued prior to the show.

No refunds will be issued if you were to miss a class.
