TRRC RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All events will be run in accordance with the current British Riding Clubs Rule Book, and specific class rules as stated in the schedule, where appropriate.
- A copy of the BRC Rule Book will be available on the day at the Secretary's office.
- 3 The Judge's decision shall be final.
- All objections shall be lodged in writing within 15 minutes of the alleged incident. A deposit of £10 required, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- 5 Neither the organisers nor the Deadman Estate, accept liability for any claims in respect of injury or damage to any person, animal or property, however caused.
- 6 The organisers reserve the right to change Judges or appoint substitutes and to amend the schedule as necessary.
- The organisers reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry made by any person or to cancel or combine any class they see fit, (refunding any fees paid less £2 per competitor to cover administrative expenses).
- 8 All entry fees must accompany entry forms. No entries will be refunded without a Vet or Doctor's Certificate.
- 9 Children **must** be kept under control and supervised at all times.
- 10 Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not. must wear a hard hat at least to BSEN 1384 or preferably PAS 015 (and to current BRC Rules, and class). Either type of headgear must have a chin strap which has a non-detachable retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination. Hat checks may be made.
- All competitors must wear the correct riding clothes whilst competing and exercising at competitions. Back protectors must be worn when XC jumps are included.
- 13 Misuse of whips or spurs will incur elimination. Blatant use of bad language or aggressive behaviour from a competitor or spectator will result in them being asked to leave immediately. They may also be banned from future TRRC events.
- 14 Car Park Steward and Competition Stewards' instructions must be followed at all times.
- 15 Entry fees (less £2 per competitor to cover administration costs) will be refunded if the event is cancelled.
- 16 All horses and ponies must be at least four years old. (In ridden classes)
- 17 Horses must be kept to a walk unless in the warm-up or competition arenas.
- The organisers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who, in their opinion, places him/herself or others in any danger or who fails to observe the rules. All competitors must act in a safe and responsible manner at all times.
