Ring 1: 10am Start

- CLASS 1** Best Turned Out – Walbridge Trust shield to the winner
- CLASS 2** Lead Rein - snaffle bridles to be worn may be split into (A show type B non-show type)
- CLASS 3** 1st Ridden may be split into (A show type B non-show type)
- CLASS 4** Veteran (horses/ponies 18 years & over) Mr. Frosty perpetual shield to the winner
- CLASS 5** Local Horse/Pony (to live within 10 miles of Bridport) MAC builders' perpetual plate to the winner
- CLASS 6** Riding Club Horse/Pony (to be judged on manners, suitability & turn out, will be required to jump a small jump)
- CLASS 7** Horse/Pony Judge would like to take home
- Short Break while the fancy dress gets ready
- CLASS 8** Fancy Dress

Ring 2: 10am start

- CLASS 10** **Cob – Ridden** - Jack Dare Perpetual Shield to the winner
- CLASS 11** **Family horse/pony** - Bridport Round Table perpetual shield to the winner
- CLASS 12** **Mountain and Moorland full & part bred - Ridden**, (may be split into small & large breeds)
- CLASS 13** **Best Rider**, 14yrs and under.
- CLASS 14** **Best Rider**, 15yrs and over

RULES

- The organisers and landowner do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
- No unauthorised person to enter rings
- Hard hats and appropriate riding clothes must be worn.
- No horse or pony under 4 years may enter any class.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- No illegal assistance by spectators.
- Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
- Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors (unless accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate).
- Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. Classes will not be held up and no entries will be refunded.
- Age (where applicable) as on the day of the show.
- The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry or entries of any Person if they shall deem it fit to do so without reasons for doing so.
- Anyone found galloping/lunging around the arenas will be asked to leave.
- The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs. Whips over 30" in length are not allowed.
- Competitors who disobey any Judge or Official's decision could be refused entry in future competitions.
- Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times. Riders arriving late may be allowed to take part at the Judge's discretion.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions, it is the competitor's responsibility to telephone the Event Secretary on 07811 292987.
- **All dogs must be kept on lead, or you will be asked to leave**
