#### **SHOW RULES**

#### **PRE-ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

- All competitors MUST pre enter at least one class before the closing date of 18<sup>th</sup> July 2025
- Further entries may be made on the day providing one class has been pre entered.
- This is an SWPA Qualifying show. All starred classes, along with all classes in Ring 4, are qualifiers.
- All persons in attendance or competing do so entirely at their own risk. The organisers and landowners will not be held responsible for any incident, loss, damage, injury or otherwise to any horse, rider, handler, dog, spectator, vehicle or property.
- All horses and ponies must be up to date with annual vaccinations. Spot checks may be made.
- Show jumping classes will be judged in accordance with BSJA rules.
- All competitors must be suitably insured for all events in which they wish to participate.
- Hard hats conforming to approved safety standards must be worn with the chin strap securely fastened at all times when mounted.
- Riding or jodhpur boots must be worn when mounted.
- Body protectors are recommended.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse or alter any entry or make changes to the schedule without prior notice and without reason.
- No entry will be refunded without written notice no later than 48 hours prior to the commencement of the show.
- Ridden horses and ponies must be at least 4 years of age.
- Stallions not to be ridden or handled by anyone under 14 years of age.
- Cantering and galloping in non-competitive areas is strictly forbidden.
- Foul language and abuse to human or animals will not be tolerated.
- Where age is mentioned, proof of age may be required.
- The show organisers strongly recommend that after any fall or incident, a visit to the medical centre is made before continuing.
- Objections must be made in writing within 30 minutes of an incident, accompanied by a £20 deposit, which shall be returned if the objection is upheld.
- Failure to comply with any of the above rules may result in ejection from the field without refund of entries.
- The decision of the organisers is **FINAL.**



At the junction with Bluebell Road, take a left and follow the road over the hump back bridge. At the junction turn left and follow the road for approximately 2 miles. 
