The correct standard of hat must be worn with a chin strap at all times when mounted unless the competitor signs a disclaimer at the secretary office.

Horse or ponies under the age of 4 years old must not be ridden on the showground

Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead

No mucking out of horseboxes on the showground

Class 1 Youngstock – 1, 2, 3 years old

Class 2 Best Gelding – may be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Class 3 Best Condition – may split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Mini Championship for 1st and 2nds

Class 4 Bonny Pony

Class 5 Novice in hand – combination not to have won 3 1st places in previous season

Class 6 Best Horse – Open to all horses 14.3 and over

Mini Championship for first and 2nds

Class 7 Partbred – may be shown natural, plaited or hogged

Class 8 Mountain and Moorland – large Breeds

Class 9 Best Cob/Heavy Type – can be shown natural, plaited or hogged

Mini Championship for first and 2nds

In Hand Supreme Championship for all Reserve and Champions

Ridden Classes – not before 12pm

Class 18 Promising Newcomer – open to horses and ponies that are 4, 5 and 6 years old

Class 19 First Ridden inc Lead Rein – judged separate - lead rein must be attached to the nose band, child 12 years and under, to be ridden in a snaffle.

Class 20 Absolute Beginners – open to horse/pony, rider any age, inc lead rein. No group canter and canter optional in individual show

Class 21 Mountain and Moorland – may be split between large and small

Class 22 Ridden Veteran – horse/pony 15 years and over

Class 23 Novice Ridden – open to horses/ponies. Combination not to have won 1st in previous season. No group canter

Novice Championship 1- All 1st and 2nd Classes 18, 19, 20, 23

Championship 2- All 1st and 2nds Classes 21, 22, 25, 26, 30

Championship 3 – All 1sts and 2nds Classes 24,27, 28, 29, 31

Ridden Supreme – For all Reserve Champions and Champions

Class 10 Veteran – 15 years and over

Class 11 Best Mare – may be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries

Class 12 Condition Regardless of Flaws – Judged purely on confirmation and going regardless of any scars or blemishes

Mini Championship for first and 2nds

Class 13 Best Handler– may split between seniors and juniors if sufficient entries

Class 14 Best Pony – open to all ponies 14.2 and under

Class 15 Best coloured – piebald, skewbald, roan, dun, cremello, palomino, spotted
