2026 DENMEAD HORSE SHOWS RULES & CONDITIONS

- 1** Organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident / injury to any person, animal or property whatsoever or however caused. **It is a condition of entry to the showground that all persons agree to indemnify the promoters and landowners against any legal action, and that they have read and understand the Rules**
- 2** All Health & Safety Notices / Rules must be followed at all times including safety dress code rulings.
- 3** All competitors hereby confirm that they hold adequate Public Liability Insurance
- 4** **NB. It is a legal requirement to carry your horse's passport when travelling it. Please have it ready for stewards to check before unboxing. Remember your Bio Security.** Please do not touch other horses and ensure you do not allow your horses to touch others.
Horses which are coughing or have a 'snotty nose' will be asked to leave. Please do not bring them.
- 5** **RESPECT THE OFFICIALS OR BE ASKED TO LEAVE.** This applies to all persons entering the Showground.
- 6** Competitors entering classes which may clash do so entirely at their own risk. **No entry fees will be refunded** unless accompanied by a doctor's or veterinary certificate. THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE AN ENTRY WITHOUT STATING THE REASON.
- 7** **Objections** must be made in writing to the Secretary together with a £60 deposit within 10 minutes of an incident. Deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld
- 8** Organisers reserve the right to alter, amalgamate or sub-divide classes should numbers so justify or to substitute other judges for those named. Judges' decisions are final. In the event of the show being cancelled a small percentage of the entry will be kept for admin costs.
- 9** **NO galloping / cantering** on showground except in arenas / practice area.
- 10** **KEEP to the correct areas/zones. Horses are not allowed in the Spectator only areas.**
Horsewalks & Collecting Rings. Only Competitors & Grooms are permitted in these areas. Please do not stop on a horsewalk.
FAMILY ZONE. These areas are near the children's arena(s) where child competitors and their families may watch and wait. Ponies must not go above a walk in these areas and Parents / Responsible Adults are asked to ensure that they are not a danger / liability to anyone else.
- 11** Novices must have an experienced person with them and not try activities beyond their capabilities.
- 12** **Stallions** must be handled / in care of experienced persons over 16 years old unless they have applied for and been given a dispensation ahead of time from the Show Director/Secretary
- 13** **CARRIAGES** may not be driven on the showground itself unless taking part in a carriage class. Competitors arriving at the showground with a carriage must unharness and leave the carriage in the designated area near the gate. They may then lead the horse to the rings
- 14** No horse/pony under 4 years of age to be ridden on showground
- 15** Persons engaging in undue use of whip will be asked to leave the showground. Max length of whip carried = 30 inches.
- 16** Horses/Ponies must not be left tied up & unattended.
- 17** **DOGS** must be on lead & not left unattended in vehicles in hot weather
- 18** **A FRANCHISE** to operate on the showground must have been obtained from the organisers in order to carry out any commercial activity, including photography.
- 19** **Parking.** Parking spaces are limited, please park responsibly and follow stewards instructions. Cars are not permitted in the Lorry lines except for unloading. Competitors parking is usually free however cars left in the Box lines will incur a £20 parking fee. There is a separate area for Competitor's cars.
- 20** Please TAKE YOUR LITTER HOME WITH YOU. Do not muck your horseboxes out onto the ground or leave your hay behind. Dog poo must be picked up
- 21** **Dress Code.**
 - a. **HATS.** Hard hats to the current safety standards must be worn **whenever mounted** & hair tied back.
Children taking part in 'in hand' classes must wear their hard hat. A rider losing their hat in the jumping arena will be eliminated.
 - b. **Correct riding dress** must be worn in all ridden classes except Fun classes.
At the Fun Shows hats & safe footwear must be worn. Clothes must be neat, tidy & safe but full showing dress is not compulsory.
 - c. **Jewellery.** Most affiliated classes do not permit jewellery or piercings apart from wedding rings. It is advisable to remove before the show and avoid being sent from the ring.
 - d. **Back protectors** to current safety standards are advised for jumping classes esp. for children.
 - e. **Tack** should be appropriate to the class. Double bridles / reins may NOT be used in Novice classes.
 - f. **WHIPS.** Max length = 30". Whips/spurs may not be used in games.
 - g. In Fun classes 'everyday' tack may be used. However, Judges may penalise if they feel the rider is relying too much on unusual biting / tack aids
- 22** **CHALLENGE TROPHIES** may be collected by the winner, not a representative, from the Trophy tent upon presentation of ID and full details & signature being given. Trophies should be returned by the date specified, if not, FULL COSTS at current rates of replacements will be charged. A small deposit (£20) is required which will be forfeit if they are returned late, to fund a replica for presentation – you will still be liable for return of the trophy or full replacement costs and the cost of making good **any damage.**
- 23** **PREPAID/discouted Entries** close at 10 pm on the Sunday one week prior to the show.
- 24** **LATE Entries** will normally be accepted at the show up until the previous class enters the ring **if there is sufficient room.** Please check with the Secretary if you are entering very close to start time of the class. Budget Show has different rules – see format
- 25** **It is essential that entries are completely filled out and signed that they are happy for the information to be used for show administration. Otherwise, they will NOT be accepted. PLEASE MAKE OUT A SEPARATE ENTRY FOR EACH COMPETITOR. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED .**

FORMAT

If you wish to do the **JUMPING PHASES only** please put a J on your entry form next to the class number. If you wish to do **DRESSAGE only** put a D after the class number.

Time allowed is generous so there is no need to hurry but time penalties will be given for excessive time taken or for excessive speed. The 2 jumping phases are against the clock but time taken will only count if the scores are equal.

Course Walks The course can be walked on Saturday after 10.30 am.

Prize Giving will take place at the end of the day after a suitable break for the scorer. Tea will be available during the scoring break. If you are not attending please leave an extra large stamped addressed envelope with the Secretary.

Dressage Tests can be found on our website www.denmeadhorseshow.co.uk and in the adjacent pages of this schedule. If you do not have access to the website please send SAE to Mrs F Hull, Seymour Cottage, Forest Rd, Denmead, PO7 6UA. These tests will also be used at the Budget Show on 23rd August, if you want a practice run. **All Dressage Tests may be called. Sections 1 & 2 may be assisted**

Dressage & Show Jumping Times will be posted on facebook on Friday evening if you cannot access these please tel: 07918 757 055 on the FRIDAY evening before the show 8 to 10pm.

Scores: are marked on what you achieve rather than penalties – if you do not like a fence leave it out and carry on! **After 3 attempts at any one fence you MUST move on.**

All section are out of 200. **Dressage:** as sheets.

Jumping: 13 jumping efforts. Each worth 15 points. Points docked for knock downs / refusals. 5 points awarded by judge's discretion on style & fluidity of jumping. Ties determined by time.

X C'try: Each jumping effort is worth 10 points. Points docked for refusals/runouts/jumping lower option /falls – you will not be eliminated except where medically required. After 3 refusals no points awarded. **YOU MUST MOVE ON.** Time allowed is generous. There is a bogey time. Penalties taken if too fast /slow
